

**STATEMENT OF DANIEL W. LICHTENSTEIN-BORIS

My name is Daniel Lichtenstein-Boris, Research Analyst III at LA County Department of Public Health and candidate for Director of the LACERA Board of Investments. I work in the Office of Environmental Justice and Climate Health helping protect residents from extreme heat and to support County efforts to reduce rates of asthma, cancer, and cardiovascular disease caused by oil and gas wells, refineries, and toxic sites.

During the pandemic I served on the Acute Communicable Disease Control COVID data and epidemiology team helping public health nurses and nursing home infection preventionists contain COVID outbreaks.

From 2012 to 2019 I was a Service Employees International Union Researcher where I worked on the We Are One Illinois coalition to challenge the constitutionality of legislation to reduce retirees' pensions at the Chicago Park District.

I performed financial analysis, summarized legislative proposals, and conducted legal research to support SEIU, AFSCME, and the Chicago Teachers Union to save pensions from attack at the Chicago Municipal Employees Annuity and Benefit Fund as well. We successfully defended the retirement security of special education assistants, custodians, maintenance workers, and security guards.
