



LOS ANGELES COUNTY FACT SHEET CITY SELECTION COMMITTEE

EXECUTIVE OFFICE



To appoint City representatives to such boards, commissions and agencies as may be required by law.



QUALIFICATIONS

The Mayor of each city within Los Angeles County.

Each city appoints an elected official (generally Mayor) as delegate to the City Selection Committee



TERM OF OFFICE Coincides with the Mayor's term.

Member's term coincides with City Mayor terms

MEMBERS*

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The Mayor of each city within Los Angeles County.



MEETINGS

Three or four times a year, at the call of the Chair.

Additional time commitment may be required.



COMPENSATION

None.

No compensation.



DUTIES*

Appoint City representatives to such boards, commissions and agencies as may be required by law.

Examples of appointments include, LAFCO, South Coast Air Quality Management District, and Metropolitan Transportation Authority (MTA).



APPOINTMENT

By each City.

MEMBERS

The membership of this City Selection Committee shall consist of the mayor of each city within Los Angeles County.

When the mayor is unable to attend a meeting of the Committee, he shall designate another member of the city's legislative body to attend and vote at the meeting in his place as his representative.

Nominations for the City Selection Committee appointees to the MTA are made by the Sector Subcommittees for the Sectors whose representatives' terms are expiring. The cities assigned to one of the four regions in Los Angeles County (North County/San Fernando Valley, San Gabriel Valley, Southeast Long Beach and Southwest Corridor) shall meet as a Sector Subcommittee. Each candidate with a majority weighted vote will then be nominated from that Sector for consideration for appointment to the MTA.



DUTIES

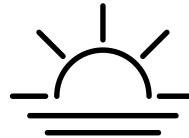
To appoint City representatives to such boards, commissions and agencies as may be required by law; i.e., LAFCO, South Coast Air Quality Management District, Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, Los Angeles County Hazardous Waste Management Advisory Committee; and to nominate for appointment members to the California Coastal Commission.

Commencing on and after July 1, 2016, the Commission may appoint one member to the Redevelopment Dissolution Oversight Board.



OATH

Not Required.



SUNSET REVIEW

Not Required.



AUTHORITY

Sections 50270 through 50279.2 of the Government Code; Section 34179 of the Health and Safety Code.

May be subject to bylaws.
