QUALIFICATIONS*

- The Los Angeles County Sheriff shall be a member of the Authority and shall appoint one other person to serve as a member of the Authority.
- The Chief of Police for the City of Los Angeles shall be a member of the Authority and shall appoint one other person to serve as a member of the Authority.
- The President of CSULA shall appoint one person to serve as a member of the Authority.

Some knowledge or experience may be required.



TERM OF OFFICE*

3 years, at the pleasure of their respective appointing officials.

The Chairperson of the Authority shall serve for one year and the members of the Authority shall rotate as Chairperson on an annual basis, in a manner to be determined by the Authority. The first Chairperson shall be the Los Angeles County Sheriff.

One regular meeting to be held each year.

May meet at such other times as may be deemed necessary by the President.

DUTIES

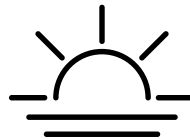

request the Sheriff to notify the City of Los Angeles, CSULA and the State Office of Criminal Justice Planning of the Authority’s action.
