ABOUT US

The Commission on HIV (COH) serves as the local planning council for the planning, allocation, coordination and delivery of HIV/AIDS and Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) services within LA County.

The COH is composed of 51 members appointed by the Board of Supervisors for a 2-year term. Members represent a broad and diverse group of providers, HIV care and prevention service consumers, and stakeholders.



WHAT WE DO

As an integrated planning body for HIV prevention and care services in Los Angeles County, the COH is responsible for:

- Setting care/treatment priorities and allocations,
- Developing a comprehensive care plan,
- Assessing the administrative mechanism of service delivery
- Evaluating service system effectiveness
- Service coordination
- Annual needs assessments
- Setting minimum service standards
- Defining ways to best meet the needs of People Living with HIV
- Resolving service system grievances
- · Promoting the availability of services
- · Evaluating other streams of funding
- Advising the Board on all County HIV funding
- Policy development and advocacy work
- Advising the Board on HIV /STD-related matters
