

LA County Board of Supervisors Public Comment System FAQs

What is the new public comment system?

A simpler way to register and speak at Board of Supervisors meetings, built for accessibility.

When does it launch?

September 1, 2026

How do I register to speak?

Go to publiccomment.lacounty.gov, pick the meeting and the item(s) you want to comment on, and submit your info. You can also register at a boardroom kiosk.

Am I required to register?

You are not required to register to make public comment, however, you will experience a delay in speaking to the Board if you are not preregistered.

Do I still need a PIN or to press 3?

There are no meeting access codes, however there are prompts when calling in.

Do I have to be there in person?

No. Once you register, you can call in from anywhere.

How will I know when it's my turn?

You'll get an automated text reminder before your item is called. When it is your turn to speak, the meeting host will call your name to let you know that your line is unmuted.

Can I speak using my computer?

Public comment is accessible in-person or by phone. All callers must call into the speaking line by calling: 213-444-2600.

Is it accessible for people with disabilities?

Yes, the system is ADA-compliant, screen-reader supported, and designed to work with assistive technology.

Can I comment anonymously?

Yes. Anonymous commenting is supported for residents who prefer privacy.
