# 4 ways to pay safely





### 1 Pay mobile in stores.

Pay mobile in stores using your Payconiq by Bancontact app, KBC Mobile or CBC Mobile. At the cash desk, scan the Payconiq QR code with your smartphone. Then, enter your PIN code on your own screen. This means you never have to touch a terminal, just your own smartphone. Android smartphone users can also pay contactless with their Payconiq by Bancontact app, on every terminal with the contactless symbol that accepts Bancontact payments.



### 2 Pay your merchant from a distance.

Pay your merchant from a distance, using the 'Shopping list'-option in the Payconiq by Bancontact app. Most merchants who accept Payconiq payments are included in that list. Click on the name of a store, enter the amount and confirm with your PIN code. This again means you never have to touch a terminal and you don't even have to go inside the shop to pay. This is a practical payment method at pick-up points or in other specific situations in which merchants deliver goods at home (i.e. meals, groceries, etc.).



### 3 Pay online.

A lot of merchants offer you the possibility to buy online or to order food, so you don't have to go to the store anymore. **Easily pay online with your Bancontact card, your bank app or the Payconiq by Bancontact app** by scanning a QR code on the payment page.



## 4 Pay contactless with your card.

Pay contactless in stores using your Bancontact card. Place the card near the contactless symbol on the payment terminal for a few seconds. For an amount of less than 25 euros, you don't have to enter your code – which also means you don't have to touch any number keys. For an amount of over 25 euros, you have to confirm using your PIN code. If these limits would change, you will be informed. It's best to disinfect the keyboard before you enter your PIN code on the payment terminal.
