By using the I-MED Radiology Network (I-MED) sites available through <http://www.i-med.com.au> (Sites) you agree that, unless, and to the extent that, you modify your browser settings, I-MED will use cookies and other similar tracking technologies (referred to collectively as “cookies”) in the manner described in this Cookie Notice.

General overview

Cookies are plain text files that contain small amounts of information that the Sites asks your browser to store on your device.

I-MED uses cookies to:

1. enable its Sites to operate as designed and enable you to use their features;
2. customise and improve the user experience on its Sites;
3. understand and interpret how its Sites are being used; and
4. enable advertising of our services to you.

All cookies obtained by I-MED on its Sites collect only anonymous information and do not collect information which can personally identify you. I-MED will only be aware of such information if you provide the information to us as described in its Privacy Statement.

Types of cookies

The types of cookies I-MED uses on its Sites may include:

- **Session cookies:** These are temporary cookies that remain in the browser until you leave the Site(s) and expire once you close the browser. They may include strictly necessary cookies, which are those that enable the Sites to work and use of their features;
- **Persistent cookies:** These are used to remember your preferences within the Sites and remain in your browser after the session has ended unless deleted by you. These are often used to understand usage patterns of the Sites and may include functional cookies that help remember your preferences if you subsequently visit the Sites again;
- **Analytic cookies:** These are used to gather statistics about the use of the Sites in order to improve the performance and design of the Sites and I-MED’s services. They may include information about your device type, system settings, information on actions taken on the sites and the dates and times of your visits, etc.;

- **Third party cookies:** These belong to and are managed by other parties, such as business partners or service providers, and may be required to allow for advertising to you outside of the Sites (e.g. on Facebook or YouTube). The use of these cookies is also subject to the third party's own cookie policies.

Changing your settings

Most browsers automatically accept cookies. You can actively disable or change your cookies settings by changing your preferences on the web browser that you use to access the Sites. In most browsers, these are contained in the 'Help', 'Internet Options' or 'Settings' toolbar or similar.

In some instances (e.g. for strictly necessary cookies) disabling cookies may affect your ability to use or access all or parts of the Sites.
