

TOP THINGS TO DO: EXPLORE CAVES

Explorers who venture underground to grand caverns and maze-like tunnel systems will discover another side to Western Australia's rugged beauty. From the limestone caves of the Margaret River Region to ancient Tunnel Creek cave in the Kimberley, join a torchlit tour or embark on a selfquided subterranean adventure to shine a light on soaring stalagmites, bizarre rock formations and atmospheric Aboriginal legends. Yanchep National Park, an hour from Perth, hosts the mesmerising Crystal Cave, rich in stalactites and stalagmites. The Margaret River Region is home to a network of 150 limestone caves dotted among soaring trees of Leeuwin-Naturaliste Ridge. Explore Mammoth, Jewel, and Lake Caves, and the culturally significant Ngilgi Cave.

ADVENTURE THE CORAL COAST TO THE MAGICAL NINGALOO REEF

HOME TO THE WORLD'S MOST EXHILARATING MARINE ADVENTURES, THE CORAL COAST EXTENDS NORTH FROM PERTH TO EXMOUTH, HUGGING THE INDIAN OCEAN FOR 1,250 KILOMETRES OF OTHERWORLDLY COASTLINE AND RUGGED NATIONAL PARKS.

The jewel of the Coral Coast is the World Heritage-listed Ningaloo Marine Park (Nyinggulu), a bucket list destination for nature and wildlife lovers and home to the 'Big 3' – whale sharks, humpback whales and manta rays. Accessible from Coral Bay or Exmouth, Ningaloo Reef is over 300-kilometres long and one of the planet's most biologically diverse marine environments. It's also the closest coral barrier reef to a land mass in the world – you can step straight off the beach and snorkel over 200 species of coral teeming with 500 species of colourful fish.

Dive, snorkel or swim Australia's largest fringing reef as whale sharks, humpback whales and manta rays glide past in a once-in-a-life-time experience. Wonders abound on land too, with pristine beaches and surf breaks that allow you to tap into your adventurous side or indulge in barefoot luxury.







TOP THINGS TO DO: SNORKELLING AND DIVING

The largest fringing reef, World Heritage marine parks, untouched coral atolls, toprated dive wrecks and encounters with a staggering array of marine life await on Western Australia's temperate and tropical coast. That's over 12,500 kilometres of snorkelling and diving experiences. This region, spanning from Rottnest Island (Wadjemup)'s Class A marine reserve to Ningaloo Reef (Nyinggulu), boasts the world's second-highest diversity of marine species. Dive into encounters with rare Australian sea lions, playful dolphins, turtles, dugongs, reef sharks, and manta rays. The highlight is swimming alongside the majestic whale shark. And beyond Ningaloo Reef (Nyinggulu), the unspoiled Rowley Shoals beckons as a dream destination for divers.



DRIVING IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

DRIVING AROUND WESTERN AUSTRALIA IS ONE OF THE BEST WAYS TO SEE THE STATE. IF YOU'RE NOT FAMILIAR WITH THE LOCAL RULES OF THE ROAD, HERE ARE SOME HINTS, TIPS AND RULES TO KEEP YOU SAFE.





DRIVING ON THE LEFT

In Australia, all vehicles drive on the left of the road.

MERGING

When merging as two lanes form one, the vehicle in front has right of way.

ROUNDABOUTS

When entering a roundabout, always give way to any vehicle already in the roundabout.

CROSSING ROAD LINES

You may cross a broken line if it is safe to do so, but continuous unbroken lines should not be crossed unless you need to avoid an obstruction

SHARING THE ROAD WITH CYCLISTS

Give way to cyclists, and when overtaking allow a distance of 1.5m between your vehicle and the cyclist.

MAKING A "U-TURN"

When making a U-Turn give way to all other road users, and use the indicator to signal your manoeuvre.

MOBILE PHONE DISTRACTION

It is illegal to use your mobile phone while driving, enjoy the view instead.

DRINK DRIVING

Driving in Western Australia with a blood alcohol level over .05 is illegal.

BUCKLE UP

Wearing seatbelts is mandatory in Western Australia, and drivers and passengers can be fined for not wearing them.

YOUR DRIVER'S LICENCE

Holders of an overseas driving licence must carry a copy of their licence with a translation, or an International Drivers' Permit while driving.

DRIVING TO WESTERN AUSTRALIA

2WD - Take the epic Eyre Highway from Port Augusta in South Australia, across the vast Nullarbor Plain to Norseman, playing a few holes on the world's longest golf course - the Nullarbor Links - along the way.

If you're driving to Western Australia from Darwin, the Victoria Highway connecting to the Great Northern Highway takes you through the spectacular Kimberley to Broome.

4WD - For a 4WD adventure across World Heritage Listed tropical savannahs, take the Savannah Way from Cairns in North Queensland to WA's exotic pearling town of Broome.

Or journey through Australia's red centre along the Outback Way. This 4WD odyssey spans 2,700 kilometres from Winton in Queensland, to Uluru and ending at Laverton in WA's Goldfields region.

Add to the adventure by hitting the legendary Gibb River Road through the Kimberley wilderness.

DRIVING ON GRAVEL ROADS

- Drive at a slower speed
- Slow down on bends
- Don't break suddenly
- Be prepared for dust and stones from passing vehicles

WILDLIFE ON THE ROAD

Be aware of roaming animals such as kangaroos, cattle, camels and even eagles on the road in some country areas, especially at sunrise and sunset.

LOW VISIBILITY

Avoid driving in hazardous weather and in rural areas. Drive with your headlights on at any time of day regardless of conditions.

REST AREAS AND PETROL STATIONS

There's lots of ground to cover and some big distances so take your time. Make the most of rest areas, some of which will have bathroom facilities, as well as barbecues and picnic benches.

It's best to stop at a petrol station or a roadhouse regularly for fuel and water when you're travelling big distances as the stops may be limited.

DOWNLOAD OFFLINE MAPS

Remote areas of Western Australia may not have phone coverage. While the roads are well-marked, it's a good idea to have an offline or paper map.

rail network is a great way to visit ons across the city and its suburbs. Within the city centre, there is a Free Transit Zone for trains travelling in the area between les fast connection from Perth CBD to he Airport Central Train Station. The trains perate every 12 minutes at peak, every 15 minutes during the day and every 30 minutes FERRY at night. Upon arriving at Airport Central Terminals 3 and 4, disembark at Redcliffe Train Station and take Bus Route 292. You can use the SmartRider card to pay for this airport service.

BUS

CAT (Central Area Transit) buses operate in buses are free and run every 5-15 minutes 1 or 2 days pass. Coach tours to Pinnacles, Margaret River and Wave Rock are available.

Using a SmartRider card enables you to take station, follow signs along the Skybridge a public ferry ride across the Swan River. Ferries depart from Elizabeth Quay Jetty to Mends Street Jetty every 15–30 minutes from 6.30am until 11.30pm. A great way to visit Perth Zoo and enjoy the scenic view of the city skyline.



GUIDELINES FOR INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS



VISA APPLICATION

Applicable to everyone (with exception for Australian or New Zealand citizens), a visa prior to travelling to Australia is required. You may apply your Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) via www.homeaffaris.gov.au

AIRPORT

There are 4 terminals at Perth Airport, make sure you go to the right terminal. The distance from the airport to Perth city is 20 minutes by car. A taxi fare from the airport to the city is approximately AUD\$50. The new Airport Line provides a fast connection from Perth CBD to the Airport Central Train Station at T1 & T2. Trains operate every 12 minutes at peak, every 15 minutes during the day and every 30 minutes at night. Upon arriving at Airport Central station, follow signs along the Skybridge walkway to access T1/T2. For T3/T4, disembark at Redcliffe Train Station and take Bus Route 292. You can use a SmartRider card to pay for this airport service. Kids play space is located in T1 International (after passport control).

CURRENCY

The currency used is Australian dollars (AUD) and is readily available at ATMs.

CLIMATE

There are four seasons in Australia: Dec-Feb (Summer), MarMay (Autumn), Jun-Aug (Winter), Sep-Nov (Spring). Plan your trip according to the season you like or activities you prefer.

TOURIST REFUND SCHEME

To claim a refund you must spend \$300 (GST inclusive) or more in the one store, get a single tax invoice and buy goods no more than 60 days before departure.

SIM CARD

The three major mobile networks in Western Australia are Telstra, Optus and Vodafone. SIM cards are available at post offices, convenience stores, petrol stations and major supermarkets. If you intend to purchase the SIM card online, do it well before your departure date. To activate your card, you'll need: Your name, Passport number and Australian address (you can use your hotel or hostel address).

BIOSECURITY & QUARANTINE

You must declare certain food, plant material (including wooden articles) and animal products on your Incoming Passenger Card. Visit www.perthairport.com.au or www.agriculture.gov.au for more information regarding prohibited items.
