**ORDER SETTING NOTICE, OPT-OUT AND FINAL APPROVAL HEARING DATES
FOR THE DIRECT PURCHASER PLAINTIFF CLASS' PRELIMINARILY-
APPROVED SETTLEMENT WITH DEFENDANT OIL PRICE INFORMATION
SERVICE, LLC ("OPIS")**

The Court, having on July 17, 2025 granted Direct Purchaser Plaintiff's Unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Settlement with Defendant OPIS (ECF No. 301), and having preliminarily approved the settlement between the DPP Settlement Class and Defendant OPIS (the "DPP-OPIS Settlement"), including the notice plan and the schedule for issuing notice and for members of the DPP Settlement Class to object and/or exclude themselves from the DPP-OPIS Settlement (the "Preliminary Approval Order," ECF No. 360) now ORDERS:

1. Notice to potential members of the DPP Settlement Class shall commence on January 15, 2026, or seven (7) days from the date of this Order. Assuming notice commences on January 15, 2026, and consistent with the schedule in the Preliminary Approval Order, the deadline for members of the DPP Settlement Class to object to and/or exclude themselves from the DPP-OPIS Settlement is April 9, 2026.
2. A Fairness Hearing regarding the DPP-OPIS Settlement is set for **June 3, 2026 at 10:00AM Central in Courtroom 1425**. Pursuant to the schedule in the Preliminary Approval Order, DPP Settlement Class Counsel shall file their motion for final

approval of the DPP-OPIS Settlement no later than 14 days before the Fairness Hearing.
