- (c) a statement under oath that the objector is a Class Member;
- (d) a statement whether the objector intends to appear at the Final Approval Hearing, either in person or through counsel;
- (e) a statement of all the objections and the specific grounds supporting the objections;
- (f) a statement whether the objection applies only to
