DECLARATION OF SUSAN WASKIEWICZ

1. I am a Project Manager at JND Legal Administration (“JND”). This Declaration is based on my personal knowledge and information provided to me by experienced JND employees and, if called on to do so, I could and would testify competently thereto.

2. JND is serving as the Settlement Administrator¹ in the above-captioned litigation (“Action”) for the purposes of administering Settlement Agreement and Releases (the “Settlement Agreement”) preliminarily approved by the Court in its Memorandum Opinion and Order on the Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement (the “Preliminary Approval Order”), dated December 16, 2025.

3. I submit this Declaration in accordance with the Settlement Agreement to confirm the implementation of the Notice Program and provide an update on settlement administration.

¹ Capitalized terms used and not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings given such terms in the Settlement Agreement.

CAFA NOTICE

4. In compliance with the Class Action Fairness Act (“CAFA”), 28 U.S.C. § 1715, Defendants directed JND to compile a CD-ROM containing the relevant court filings, orders and proposed notice in the Settlement, along with the names of Class Members who reside in each state and their estimated proportionate share of the claims. The list of documents included in the CD-ROM is outlined in the CAFA cover letter. A representative sample of the CAFA cover letter and recipient list of the appropriate Federal and State officials is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

5. The CD-ROM, CAFA cover letter and recipient list were mailed to the appropriate Federal and State officials identified in Exhibit A on September 26, 2025.

CLASS MEMBER DATA

6. On December 18, 2025, JND received a spreadsheet containing, among other information, the names, mailing addresses, email addresses, electronic disclosure information, membership statuses, and member numbers of individuals identified as potential Class Members. The spreadsheet contained contact information for 127,242 unique individuals. Of the 127, 242 unique individuals, 144 did not have mailing addresses.

7. Between December 18, 2025 and February 5, 2026, JND received mailing address information for 144 unique individuals included in the initial spreadsheet without mailing addresses.

8. Upon data receipt JND updated the Class Member contact information using data from the National Change of Address (“NCOA”) database. The Class Member data was promptly loaded into a database established for this Action.

EMAIL NOTICE CAMPAIGN

9. On January 20, 2026, JND sent the Court-approved Email Notice by email to the 65,042 Class Member records with valid email addresses, who also consented to receiving electronic communications. In total, 63,114 (97.04%) Email Notices were successfully delivered, and 1,928 (2.96%) were undeliverable. A representative sample of the Email Notice is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

DIRECT NOTICE MAILING

10. On January 20, 2026, JND sent the Court-approved Postcard Notice via U.S. Postal Service first-class mail. The Postcard Notices were sent to the 62,156 Class Members with known addresses who did not agree to receive electronic communications from the Defendants. A representative sample of the Notice is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**.

11. On February 12, 2026, JND mailed an additional 1,928 Postcard Notices to Class Members who consented to receiving electronic communications, but where the sending of the Email Notice was unsuccessful.

12. Between January 20, 2026 and February 27, 2026, JND mailed 44 additional Postcard Notices to Class Members who received address updates from Defense Counsel and who did not agree to receive electronic communications from the Defendants.

13. As of March 12, 2026, of the total 64,128 Postcard Notices mailed, JND received 511 undeliverable Postcard Notices. In accordance with the Settlement, JND re-mailed 5 Postcard Notices that were returned with forwarding address information. JND also conducted advanced address searches for records with undeliverable Postcard Notices that did not have forwarding address information and re-mailed the Postcard Notices to the Class Members' updated addresses, resulting in the re-mail of 165 Postcard Notices. Of the 165 Postcard Notices re-mailed, 14 have been returned as undeliverable.

14. In total, 63,773 (99.45%) of the mailed Postcard Notices have not been returned to

JND to date, and 355 (0.55%) mailed Postcard Notices were returned to JND.

15. To date, a total of 126,887 of the 127,242 attempted Notices were successfully delivered, resulting in a 99.72% success rate.

SETTLEMENT WEBSITE

16. On January 20, 2026, JND established a dedicated website for the Action (www.USAALateFeeLitigation.com), which hosts downloadable copies of important case documents (including, but not limited to, the Notice, Settlement Agreement, Class Action Complaint, and Preliminary Approval Order), provides answers to frequently asked questions, and includes contact information for the Settlement Administrator.

17. As of March 12, 2026, the website has tracked 5,752 unique users who registered 8,140 page views.

TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE LINE

18. On January 20, 2026, JND activated a case-specific toll-free number, 1-877-206-2306, for Class Members to call to obtain information about the Settlement. The telephone line is available 24 hours a day, seven (7) days a week.

19. As of March 12, 2026, the toll-free number has received 251 calls.

REQUESTS FOR EXCLUSION

20. The Notice informed Class Members who wanted to exclude themselves from the Settlement (“opt-out”) that they must do so by submitting an exclusion request letter to the Settlement Administrator, received or postmarked on or before March 30, 2026.

21. As of March 12, 2026, 4 Class Members have requested exclusion. Copies of these exclusion requests are attached hereto as **Exhibit D**.


OBJECTIONS

23. As of March 12, 2026, JND has not received any objections.

You received this notice because records indicate you are a Settlement Class Member and you have the right to know about the settlement and your rights and options before the Court decides the outcome.

Am I a Settlement Class Member?

You are a Settlement Class Member if you meet the following criteria:

- ✓ You were charged a late fee by USAA General Indemnity Company, Garrison Property and Casualty Insurance Company, United Services Automobile Association, or USAA Casualty Insurance Company (collectively, "USAA Defendants") on a Maryland insurance policy prior to 2020;
- ✓ You received a refund for those late fee charges pursuant to Maryland Consent Order MIA-2020-08-002;
- ✓ You did **not** receive accrued interest and/or gains on the late fee refund.

What is the lawsuit about?

A settlement has been reached in a class action lawsuit called *Black et al. v. USAA General Indemnity Company et. al.*, No. 8:21-CV-01581-LKG pending in the United States District Court for the District of Maryland. The lawsuit concerns certain late fees that were refunded by USAA Defendants on Maryland insurance policies. Plaintiffs believe that USAA Defendants should have refunded the gains and/or interest they accrued on the late fees. USAA Defendants deny they did anything wrong or owe anyone money. The Settlement is a compromise to end the lawsuit – it does not determine who is right.

What does the settlement provide?

USAA Defendants have agreed to create a **\$5,000,000** Settlement Fund. The exact payment amount you will get depends on several things including how many late fees you were charged and how long ago you paid the late fee(s), as well as the total

number of Settlement Class Members (less any who opt out of the settlement). If there is money left after the claims process is completed, it will be donated to Wounded Warrior Project and Face the Fight.

Your options

You have three options:

- 1. Do nothing.** Automatically get a payment either in the form of a statement credit (for Current Policyholders) or in the form of a check (for Former Policyholders). Be bound by settlement.
- 2. Opt Out of the settlement by March 30, 2026.** Get no payment. This is the only option that allows you to keep the right to sue USAA Defendants about the same issues that the settlement resolves.
- 3. Object by March 30, 2026.** Tell the court why you don't like the settlement. Still get an automatic payment and be bound by the settlement.

Who represents the Settlement Class?

The Court appointed Andrea R. Gold and Gemma Seidita of Tycko & Zavareei LLP; Jonathan Kagan of Kagan Stern Marinello & Beard LLC; and Keith T. Vernon and Andrew W. Knox of Timoney Knox, LLP to represent the Settlement Class as Settlement Class Counsel. Settlement Class Counsel will ask the Court to approve a payment of up to \$2,000,000 total in attorneys' fees plus the reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses, and a payment of \$7,500 to Settlement Class Representative Walter Black III, and \$3,500 each to Settlement Class Representatives Keith Barr, Wayne Best, and David Fant, Sr. for the time and effort they contributed to the case.

These payments will be deducted from the \$5,000,000 Settlement Fund.

What happens next?

The Court will hold a Final Approval hearing to decide whether to approve the settlement. The hearing will be held at 10 a.m. on April 28, 2026 at 500 Cherrywood Lane, Suite 400, Greenbelt, MD 20770. Payments will only be made if the Court approves the settlement. You don't have to attend the hearing, but you may at your own expense. You may also ask the Court for permission to speak and express your opinion about the settlement.

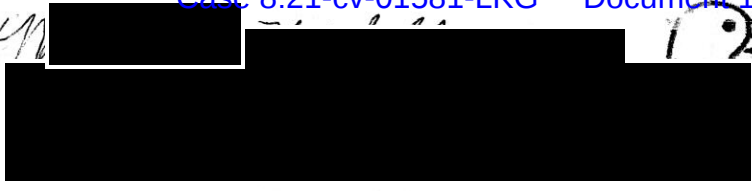

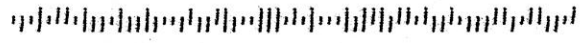

My mother, D [REDACTED] Harvey, received the class action notice regarding Black v. USAA court case. A copy of that notice is enclosed. She died [REDACTED]. I don't have the last four digits of her former policy, and she didn't drive the last five years of her life. All of her documentation has been disposed of long ago.

I'm not clear what her membership in the settlement class is. Again, she hadn't driven a car since prior to 2016. I doubt she had any late fees since she was always timely with her bill payments. Therefore, I can't see any reason she would have received a rebate of late fees.

For these reason I would like to remove her from the settlement class and opt out of any potential payments. Her estate was closed in 2024, and I have no desire for her to receive any payments as a result.
