**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR  
APPROVAL OF PROPOSED CLASS NOTICE PLAN**

Now before the Court is Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of Proposed Class Notice Plan.

The Court having reviewed the Motion, its accompanying memorandum, and its declaration and exhibits attached thereto, finds that Plaintiffs' proposed Notice Plan satisfies the requirements of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23 and due process in that it constitutes the best notice practicable under the circumstances.


The Court hereby **ORDERS** that Plaintiffs' Motion for Approval of Proposed Class Notice Plan is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The Court approves the proposed Class Notice Plan.
2. The Court appoints JND Legal Administration as the notice administrator.
3. The Court orders that the Class Notice Plan be implemented in accordance with the following schedule:

Deadline for the commencement of disseminating class notice	20 days after entry of the order approving the proposed Class Notice Plan
Deadline for class members to opt out of the damages class	60 days from the publication of the notice in GGB
Deadline for Plaintiffs to submit report of Notice Plan completion and identification of opt outs from the damages class	80 days from the publication of the notice in GGB
