



OVERVIEW

Identifying the biological mechanisms driving neurodegenerative diseases, including Alzheimer's Disease, Parkinson's Disease, ALS, and Frontotemporal Dementia remains a critical barrier to the development of effective diagnostics and therapies. While the Global Neurodegeneration Proteomics Consortium (GNPC) established the value of large-scale harmonized proteomics via release of its v1 dataset in mid-2025, Alamar Biosciences' NULISA platform now enables a next phase of growth via a sensitive, scalable, and standardized targeted assay across many additional cohorts.

Launched in 2025, the NULISA NeuroData Commons applies a single next-generation assay platform across global neurodegenerative disease cohorts, profiling >40,000 new samples from longitudinal studies, genetic cohorts, and clinical trials. The NULISA CNS panel serves as the common baseline, enabling cross-cohort comparability and large-scale aggregation. All data will be processed through the AD Workbench, a secure and standardized environment, with a unified high-density dataset available to consortium members, followed by broader community access after a 6-month embargo.

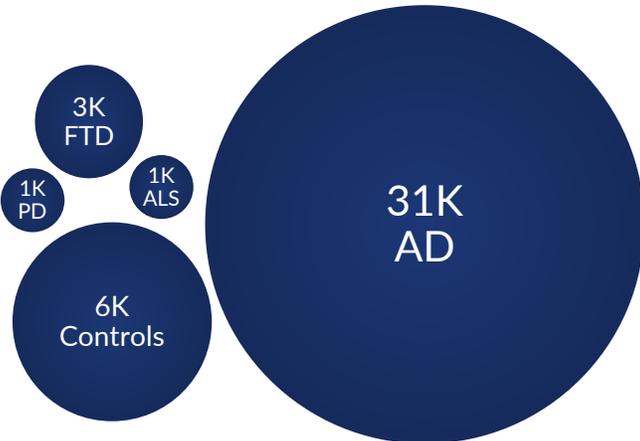

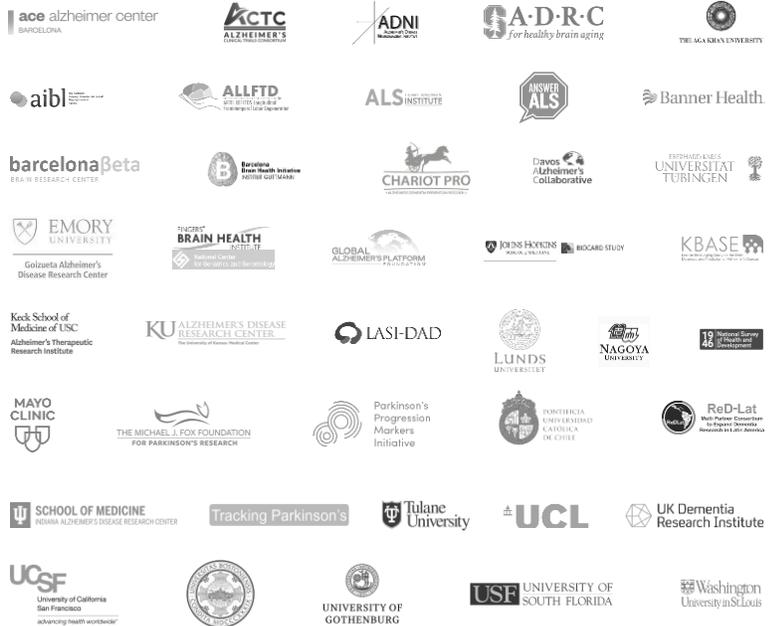
