


What Is A Trade Show



A trade show brings together an industry. It gives all the different aspects of the apparel business an opportunity to come together to display, demonstrate and discuss their latest products and services.

Typically 2-3 days long

Typically held at a convention center

- ASI Advertising Specialty Industry (promotional Products)
- What you will see—

About 600 suppliers

- Famous key note speaker

 - Terry Bradshaw in Chicago

Industry Trade Shows-ASI

Locations:

ASI Orlando - January 5-6 ASI Fort Worth - February 4-5 ASI Chicago - July 22-23





Industry Trade Shows-ASI

Cost:

- Hotels are discounted about \$150/night
- Members get free admission; if not a member, cost is \$10/day
- Education is free to members; \$199 for non-members





Industry Trade Shows-PPAI



- PPAI is Promotional Products Association International
- Similar exhibitors as ASI
- Education spread over 4 days
- To attend must be PPAI member or verified ASI supplier
- Cost: free if register early (by December 21), \$49 if register two weeks before or at door
- Keynotes each day (less known than ASI speakers)
- Education tracks

Incentives, Corporate Responsibility, Marketing, Decorate, Diversity, Sales, Strategies, New to Industry, Customer Service and SAGE

Industry Trade Shows-Impressions Expo

- Put on by Impressions Magazine rebranded for 2020 from Imprinted Sportswear Show (ISS) to Impressions Expo
- Largest custom apparel industry shows in US (Long Beach and Atlantic City)
- All about decorated apparel more focused than ASI/PPAI
- Screen printing and embroidery demos common
- Education sessions show sponsored for fee and in booth (free)
- Open to all apparel businesses, no membership needed





Industry Trade Shows-Impressions Expo





Industry Trade Shows-Impressions Expo

Cost:

Expo Floor Pass Free if register early \$36 Pre-register last three weeks

\$45 at the door

Single Workshop (includes Expo Floor Pass)

\$55 if register early

\$75 Pre-register last three weeks

\$100 at the door

Seminars (includes all seminars, floor pass, no workshops)

\$135 if register early \$180 Pre-register last three

\$180 Pre-register last three weeks

\$225 at the door

Full Package (Expo pass, workshops and seminars) \$180 if register early \$249 Pre-register last three weeks \$300 at the door






Industry Trade Shows-NBM Shows



- NBM is National Business Media who issues Printwear, Sign & Digital Graphics, and Awards & Engraving (show is divided into these segments)
- Smaller than Impressions but still has all major exhibitors
- Business to Business, no membership is needed

Industry Trade Shows-NBM Shows

Cost:

Early registration is FREE until the day before the show and includes unlimited education!

At the door admission is \$25





Industry Trade Shows-DAX

Kansas CityTreasure Island, MNFebruary 21-22, 2020April 3-4, 2020





- Smaller show, more time with exhibitors
- In class education and on floor education
- Located at smaller venues with free parking
- Free and anyone can attend, perfect if just starting or thinking of starting a t-shirt business

April 24-25, 2020






Industry Trade Shows-NNEP



May 1-2, 2020 at the Cobb Galleria Centre Atlanta



- Emphasis on embroiderers, but apparel and other decorating methods are present
- Education included
- Cost not announced, free to early registrants





Industry Trade Shows-EEM



- EEM is Everything Embroidery Market
- Smallest show we exhibit at but super fun!
- Geared more for crafters and small home businesses
- Tickets: \$28
- Most education included, including our session
- Some education sessions such as Silhouette Workshop have a fee, this one \$125



Trade Show Tips

Be prepared to be scanned!

- Take your registration to use kiosks
- Be sure your info is accurate so you get what you request





Trade Show Tips

Great show special deals

We never sell heat presses for any less than the cash and carry at a show





Trade Show Tips

- Wear comfortable shoes
- Casual dress is appropriate
- Wheeled bags are cool and can save your strength
- Many shows do not allow children due to safety (equipment is operating)
- Use exhibitor list to plan your "must sees"
- Stop by the Transfer Express booth and press your own free t-shirt!
