

HOW MUCH SPACE IS NEEDED

6 Feet

- Heat press
- Stack of unapplied transfers
- Stack of unapplied shirts
- Stack of applied shirts





HOW MUCH SPACE IS NEEDED

Another alternative is the Heat Press Caddie


• Holds the press, transfers and unapplied shirts

Tip: Bring over a chair to stack the finished apparel

- Sold in packs of 10

- Helps with static cold peel transfers
- Protects previous printing



Quick Slip Pad Protector

- Allows for easy threading
- Keeps bottom platen ink free





Mousepads

- Raise print area on hoodies
- Raise print area on left chest
- Easily cut to fit "odd" spaces





Your order has gone through our quality check but things can happen during shipping and/or a misunderstanding of your needs

Quick checks

- Quantity there typically is an extra or two just in case
- Ink color
- Size
- Spelling





Print only what you have sold

Transfers can be applied between 4-15 seconds depending on the product, so only press what you have sold to prevent excess inventory/waste

Goof Proof Transfers: 4 Second Application & Hot Peel





Before starting to print

- Cut all of your gang sheets first and put them in stacks by images you are pressing
- If doing names/numbers, get them organized by player in order
- Lay shirts out by how you can grab them and put them right on the press without turning them around/upside down



Assembly line concept

- Unapplied shirts one side (pre-sorted by size)
- Stack of transfers
- Applied shirts





Eliminate extra motions/steps

- Keep transfers/shirts and finished shirts close to you to prevent walking away from your press between every shirt
- Utilize space around you (left and right sides, above press, etc) so you just pivot your body – pull up folding chairs beside you if needed
- Use alignment tools sparingly use for the first few to get your bearings, then eyeball the rest once you have an idea where they go





Eliminate extra motions/steps

- If pressing fronts and backs, press front and then swivel the shirt to the back side to print immediately.
- Quick Slip Pad Protector helps to turn garment without removing from press.
- Eliminates extra movements of taking completely off of press and threading again
- The more times you touch each item, it is a wasted motion which adds up in volume/time



Tag Along[™] HP Platen

- Print the front design and inside tag at the same time
- Eliminates the need for a second hit and handling the garment a second time on the press
- Comes with the Quick Slip Pad Protector





 - Air conditioning
 - Heating
- Keep away from dampness
- Use the boxes to label and stack
