Pembina Pipeline Corporation's LPG Prince Rupert Terminal is nearing completion. As part of that completion and dry commissioning process we need to conduct a series of air tests, horn tests, emergency response tests and overall site preparedness before we start to introduce any hydrocarbon into the facility. Over the next 7 to 10 days, as we conduct these tests, you may hear various horns, pressurized air releases and or loud unfamiliar noises. We are reaching out to all of you to assure you that these are only tests, and part of normal dry commissioning activities. There will be no hydrocarbon release and there should be no reason for concern. These tests will only be conducted during the hours of 7:00AM – 8:00PM and we will do our best to not disturb anyone during the night.
