- This year we're celebrating the 10-year anniversary of the I Am the Gold Standard by honoring outstanding R.T.s and honoring educators with a special Educator Award. You can submit a nomination for either or both awards.

Your nomination should highlight the nominee's accomplishments in at least one of these three areas.

Educational Quality & Student Outcomes

Led or contributed to improvements in education quality and student preparedness for safe practice.

Mentorship & Professional Development

Provided exceptional support and guidance to students or led efforts that enhanced the overall student experience.

Educational Advancements & Advocacy

Demonstrated strong commitment to advancing medical imaging and radiation therapy education or promoting the profession.
