ARRT Discipline Documents:

- ✓ ARRT discipline documents undergo review approximately every five years as part of a Practice Analysis process.
- ✓ These documents can be found on the ARRT website (www.arrt.org) under the Discipline Documents section.

ARRT Discipline Documents Include:

- Task Inventory or, for the Registered Radiologist Assistant (R.R.A.), Entry-Level Clinical Activities (ELCA).
- Content Specifications includes the Content Outline used to guide examination content.
- Didactic Competency Requirements for primary pathway disciplines.
- Clinical Competency Requirements for primary pathway disciplines.
- Clinical Experience Requirements for postprimary pathway disciplines.

- ARRT Content Outline
- ARRT Task Inventory or Entry-Level Clinical Activities (ELCA)
