An information session for tourism investors/operators to learn more about the Hamersley Inlet Reserve opportunity was held on 30 March 2026. Refer below supplementary questions and answers raised at the Information session.

Is Hamersley Inlet Reserve accessible year-round?

Yes, Hamersley Inlet Reserve is accessible year-round thanks to the sealed road connection from Hopetoun and the semi-mediterranean climate. The seasons bring varied experiences for visitors to this unique destination i.e. wildflowers, fauna and perfect hiking weather.

The Shire has recently invested in star link towers to boost mobile reception in the park

Is visitation mostly from local Perth/Western Australian residents?

No, visitation comprises eastern states travellers and international visitors mainly. Fitzgerald National Park is a well-known stop amongst travellers circumnavigating Australia.

Is there access to Hamersley Beach from the day-use area?

Yes, there is a spur track connecting the day-use area with the Hakea walking trail that follows the coastline. The day-use area is approximately 400m from Hamersley Beach and approximately 200m from Hamersley Dunes.

The access road into the Reserve and parking at the day-use area is sealed.
