



ROACH CLEANOUT SERVICE

Successful control of a roach infestation relies heavily on customer participation. Sanitation is critical in preparing for treatment and preventing roaches from returning.

Before your treatment, be sure to do the following:

- **Leave the premises** - All people and pests must be off the premises before the treatment begins.
- **Clean hidden surfaces** - Be sure you clean under cabinets, sinks, stove, refrigerators, microwaves, etc.
- **Clean storage areas** - It is important to make sure items stored in cabinets and pantries, storage bins are removed from kitchens and bathrooms and placed in sealed storage containers.
- **Remove items from treatment areas** - Make sure dishes, Tupperware, pots, pans, cleaners, etc. are removed from cabinets. Unload your dishwasher and make sure that there are not items on the stove or countertops.
- **Remove pet items** - Pet items such as food and water bowls or toys should be picked up and removed from treatment area.
- **Vacuum and take out the trash** - Vacuum to eliminate any debris or roach carcasses. Garbage should be taken outdoors away from the structure that is being treated.

After your treatment:

- Wait 2 to 4 hours after the treatment is complete before reentering
- Thoroughly clean by vacuuming any roach carcasses or other debris, wiping down countertops, cabinets, and appliances.
- Wash all dishes, pots, pans, and Tupperware
- Place all items from cabinets in storage bins back in place

Keeping your home roach free:

- You will need to have an additional service in 7-14 days
- Be sure to keep your home clean by wiping up spills, not leaving dirty dishes or food scraps out overnight, rinsing cans and bottles before placing them in the trash, running your dishwasher regularly, and taking out the trash daily
- Keep your food stored in tightly sealed containers
- Inspect groceries before storing and inspect children's backpacks and lunchboxes regularly
- Do not leave pet food out overnight. Keep pet food in a sealed container and clean pet bowls when food is removed.
- Seal potential entry points by caulking gaps around doors and windows or installing new door sweeps if needed. Any plumbing leaks should also be fixed in a timely manner
