

Bord Gáis Energy GDPR Guide

From 25th May 2018, a new data protection law will be in force in Ireland; it's called GDPR.

At Bord Gáis Energy (part of the Centrica group of companies) we use personal data of our customers, and so we want to highlight what this new law means for you.

This guide contains a summary of the law and your rights. In line with GDPR, we have also updated the Privacy Notices which apply to you. These are more detailed than our previous Privacy Notices. They are available on our website at www.bordgaisenergy.ie/dataprotection. Please review them carefully.

A little bit about the GDPR

'GDPR' stands for 'General Data Protection Regulation'. It is a piece of legislation that comes from the EU (European Union). GDPR updates data protection laws in all EU member states. A key feature of GDPR is that 'data controllers' like Bord Gáis Energy must provide more information to you on how we use your data. GDPR also gives you more rights as a 'data subject'.

Does Bord Gáis Energy share my personal data?

As you can imagine, we work with a lot of companies to keep our business going. We sometimes need to share customer data with these entities. We use third parties for things like operating our call centres, printing our bills and other documents,

conducting sales activities, providing bill payment facilities, debt recovery services, marketing and managing our IT systems. We also use third party companies who assist us with legal and financial compliance. We sometimes share personal data within the Centrica group of companies. Some third parties are state or government bodies, like networks companies who need your account information to connect you to Ireland's gas or electricity networks.

How long do we keep personal information for?

We will keep your personal information for as long as you have an account with us. After you close your account with us we need

to keep certain personal information for a reasonable period to maintain our records and legal obligations to you.
