ARTICLE 1 – ORGANISING COMPANY

Those wishing to participate in this Competition must register using a QR code made available at the booth by the Organiser.

ARTICLE 4 – PERSONAL DATA

The personal data processed by the organising company in its capacity as data controller is for the purpose of organising and managing the Competition.

ARTICLE 5 – ELECTION OF THE WINNERS

In the event of a dispute, the competent courts are those of the Organiser's head office (jurisdiction in Geneva).
