Introduction

Effective management and engaging leadership help SMEs in the engineering and manufacturing sector to thrive. Leaders and managers that are self-aware, show empathy, communicate well, and engage inclusively with their teams see the results of increased productivity and better performance.

The Lead to Succeed programme has been specially designed for manufacturing and engineering sector SMEs with the aim of improving and enriching the leadership and management skills that underpin business success. The programme has been created by Enginuity, the skills charity for the engineering and manufacturing sector, in partnership with leadership development experts, Prime Progress, to offer 20 SMEs the opportunity to train one of its leaders at a highly subsidised rate as part of the programme's pilot. Who should take part?

The programme is suitable for individuals working at any level who have some form of line management responsibility. The Lead to Succeed programme is available to those managers who have not previously engaged in any formal (paidfor) leadership training. Where possible, participants with similar experience levels will train together.

Why invest in leadership training?

Engineers have the power to change the world and the sector relies on effective leaders with a clear vision, and the skills to inspire, engage and motivate the workforce. Busy SMEs are the lifeblood of the engineering and manufacturing sector and often struggle to invest the time and resources for leadership training. Lead to Succeed helps to overcome these barriers by offering a modular training approach with just eight days of face-to-face contact over a 13-month period. For this introductory phase, Enginuity will subsidise the price of the programme by 75%.

Your commitment to the programme

You must ensure that the nominated participant has given their consent to take part in the Lead to Succeed programme and understands the commitment required of them. They will need to commit to a 13-month learning journey involving eight days of face-to-face activities and online sessions spanning a total of 6.5 hours. Participants will be grouped in supportive trios and will be required to meet up online five times (approximately every two months) for around one hour outside formal sessions. You must agree to provide them with time away from work to take part. Participants are expected to fully immerse themselves in the face-to-face sessions without distractions or interruptions as far as possible.

Commitment to success

Enginuity is a charitable organisation and funding for this programme is deployed to deliver a charitable impact on your organisation and the wider sector. So that we can effectively measure the impact of the programme, you must agree to allow us to record the tangible and intangible benefits it delivers and to keep in touch with participants beyond the end of the programme to keep a record of their progress and achievements.

Your investment in leadership

The Lead to Succeed programme is majority funded by Enginuity and your organisation will pay only a small contribution. The price of the programme is ± 2.200 plus VAT per participant and Enginuity will subsidise this as follows:

Per participant

- ◆ Enginuity's contribution (75%): £1,650 plus VAT
- Cost to you (25%): £550 plus VAT and accommodation and travel costs

Payment of the employment contribution will be required before the programme commences as this is an important indication of your commitment to its success. We understand that circumstances may on occasion lead to participants being unable to take part in a face-to-face session. However, if more than one in-person session is missed or the participant withdraws from the programme before it is fully completed, Enginuity reserves the right to claim the full price of the programme (£2,200) from the participating employer.

Timescales & programme dates

The next cohort will commence in September 2024. Each cohort will consist of 12 – 15 participants.
