Employability skills

International Foundation Year

The International Foundation Year will develop your academic knowledge and English language skills to prepare you for the first year of your chosen undergraduate degree at the University of Huddersfield.

You can choose to study the International Foundation Year in one of four subject pathways:

- Art, Media and Architecture
- Business, Management and Law
- Engineering, Computing and Science
- Humanities, Health and Human Sciences.

Key facts

Course length: Two semesters

Entry dates: September or January

Age on entry: 17+ (must turn 18 before the start of your undergraduate degree)

Entry requirements

Academic: Good high school graduation grades or equivalent

English language: SELT equivalent to IELTS 4.5 (minimum of 4.0 in writing).*

Modules

You will cover core modules in all four pathways, including English language and study skills aimed to give you the language and related academic skills to reach your full potential at university.

Alongside your core modules, you will also study subject-specific modules related to your chosen programme, which are significant for your academic development.

Progression degrees

Upon successfully completing the programme with the required grades, you can choose from 120+ progression degrees available from the International Foundation Year, including:

- Business Management BA (Hons)
- Computer Science BSc (Hons)
- Mechanical Engineering BEng (Hons)
- Music BMus (Hons)
- Psychology BSc (Hons).

English Language Preparation for International Foundation Year

If you do not meet the English language requirements to study the International Foundation Year, you can join the English Language Preparation programme to develop and improve your English language ability.

The International Year One will develop your academic knowledge and English language skills, whilst preparing you to progress to the second year of your chosen undergraduate degree.

You can choose to study the International Year One in one of two subject pathways:

- Business, Management and Marketing
- Engineering and Computer Science.

Age on entry: 17+ (must turn 18 before the start of your undergraduate degree)

Entry requirements

Academic: Good high school graduation grades or equivalent

English language: Academic IELTS for UKVI 5.5 (minimum of 5.5 in all components).*

Modules

You will cover core modules in all four pathways, including English language and study skills, to allow you to reach your full potential at university.

Progression degrees

Once you successfully complete the programme and have achieved the required grades, you can progress to your chosen undergraduate degree. A wide range of progression degrees are available to progressing students, including:

Entry requirements

8-week Pre-Sessional English Programme

Academic IELTS for UKVI of 5.0 (with 5.0 in all components), for start in July or October.

12-week Pre-Sessional English Programme

Academic IELTS for UKVI of 4.5 (with 4.5 in all components), for start in June or September.

Combined visa

Save time and progress smoothly to the University with a combined visa to cover the duration of your studies at both the International Study Centre and the University of Huddersfield. You will not need to return home to apply for a new visa between your International Year One and undergraduate degree.

Pre-Master's

By choosing this accelerated, 12-week programme, you will gain the specialist academic and English language support you need to succeed in your Master's degree at the University.

Offered in one Pre-Master's subject pathway option - Business, Management and Marketing - the Pre-Master's will allow you to progress to a great range of postgraduate degrees.

Key facts

Course length: 12 weeks

Entry dates: September or June

Age on entry: 20+

Entry requirements

Academic: Successful completion, with appropriate grades, of a university or college degree, or equivalent

English language: Academic IELTS for UKVI 5.5 (minimum of 5.5 in all components).*

Modules

Classes for the Pre-Master's are modular in structure, meaning you will study a combination of core modules common to each route, and route-specific modules designed to focus on the subject area most relevant to your future Master's degree.

Progression degrees

Once you complete the programme and have achieved the necessary grades, you can progress to your chosen Master's degree. There are a wide range of progression degrees available to successful students, including:

- Accountancy and Finance MSc
- Business Intelligence and Analytics MSc
- International Business MSc
- Management MSc
- Management with International Business MSc.

Pre-Sessional English for Pre-Master's

If you do not meet the English language requirements to study the Pre-Master's, you can join the Pre-Sessional English programme to develop and improve your English language ability.

Entry requirements

8-week Pre-Sessional English Programme

Academic IELTS for UKVI of 5.0 (minimum 5.0 in all components), for start in April or July.

12-week Pre-Sessional English Programme

Academic IELTS for UKVI of 4.5 (minimum 4.5 in all components), for start in March or June.

Combined visa
