

Next Steps for Undergraduate Admitted Students

(a guide for our agent partners)

After an undergraduate student is admitted to DePaul, a "Next Steps" checklist will appear in their portal (Blue Demon Domain). As their agent, we appreciate your support in ensuring these checklist items are completed in a timely manner.

IMPORTANT!!!

Many students want to wait until they've obtained their visa to work on their Next Steps. Students SHOULD NOT wait to obtain their visa before completing their Next Steps.

When should a student begin completing their Next Steps?

- Students are able to start their Next Steps as soon as they are admitted to DePaul.
- The checklist will appear on their home page in the portal.
- Some items require previous items to be completed first, so working from top to bottom is important.
- DO NOT WAIT UNTIL A VISA IS OBTAINED TO BEGIN THESE NEXT STEPS.

What are the benefits of completing the Next Steps?

• This checklist helps students to enroll at DePaul.



- If completed in a timely manner, students will have priority consideration for their first choice in *housing*, *orientation dates*, *and classes* for the first quarter.
- If they wait to complete the Next Steps, their transition to life in the US will be much more stressful than it has to be.

Which next steps are most important?

- All of them! But students should prioritize:
 - Respond to Offer and Pay Admission Deposit (\$200)
 - Submit Proof of COVID Vaccination (must be completed before students can register for orientation and classes)
 - Request I-20
 - Complete Math and English Placement Tests (must be completed before orientation)
 - Register for Orientation (includes scheduling academic advising)
