• **Biotechnology, BS***

The Bachelor of Science in Biotechnology at CSU San Marcos will prepare you to succeed and excel in various entry-level positions within the biotechnology/life sciences industry. San Diego County boasts one of the largest biotechnology/life sciences industry clusters globally, creating substantial workforce demand for scientists and technicians locally. The curriculum integrates both science and business coursework, offering you the flexibility to pursue roles in laboratory settings or in the management and marketing operations of biotechnology. Throughout your studies, you will acquire specific knowledge and skills, including applying biological principles to solve biotechnological challenges, integrating legal, ethical, and business perspectives, developing effective scientific communications through presentations, and utilizing quantitative and computational tools to address industry-specific problems.

• **Kinesiology, BS**

The Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology at Cal State San Marcos will prepare you for various careers in rehabilitation, wellness, fitness, public health, and education. The department is a member of the American Kinesiology Association.

You can choose between two concentration options:

Health Science: This option will prepare you for professional service in public health, health/fitness education and promotion, wellness coaching, health research, and community health advocacy. You will gain skills to promote positive personal behavior changes impacting individual and community health, and you will be well-prepared for graduate programs in public health, nursing, kinesiology, and health science.

Movement Science: This option will prepare you for professional study in health-related fields such as physical therapy, physician assistant, nursing, and prosthetics, requiring rigorous science preparation. Graduates will also be prepared for careers in personal training, cardiac rehabilitation, nutrition consulting, corporate fitness, orthopedic rehabilitation settings, and more.

COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

- **Business Administration: Global Supply Chain Management, BS**

The Global Supply Chain Management Option within the Operations and Supply Chain Management Department at CSU San Marcos will teach you how to perform the key responsibilities of a supply chain manager on a global scale. You will learn to design and oversee the relationships critical to the seamless movement of products worldwide. You will gain insights into consumer behavior and product creation, covering aspects such as production planning, market entry strategies, material sourcing, procurement decisions, inventory management, marketing strategies, and optimal shipping methods to meet consumer demand. This program will also equip you with the skills to manage the entire global supply network of modern companies, including supplier relationships, manufacturing or service delivery, distribution and marketing, and customer relationship management.

- **Business Administration: Management Information Systems, BS**

The Management Information Systems (MIS) Option at CSU San Marcos offers a series of courses that integrate technical and managerial perspectives in Information Systems. You will learn diverse methods to efficiently manage and optimize information systems for modern organizations. Through hands-on learning, you will develop deep expertise in cutting-edge technologies including business information systems, database management, networking, cybersecurity, and artificial intelligence applications. Graduates of this program will have various career opportunities, including roles as IT Analysts, Cybersecurity Analysts, Business Intelligence Analysts, Database Administrators, Systems Administrators, Network Administrators, Technical Support Specialists, Business Application Developers, Systems Analysts, and Information Systems Managers.

SAN MARCOS

San Marcos, nestled in the scenic foothills of northern San Diego County, offers an exceptional living experience for over 95,000 residents. With miles of picturesque trails and a variety of dining and shopping options, San Marcos provides a vibrant backdrop for university life. Just a short drive south, downtown San Diego awaits with its bustling attractions, while to the west, the stunning Pacific Ocean offers endless recreational opportunities.

Despite its growth, San Marcos maintains a charming small-town atmosphere that appeals to newcomers seeking a friendly community. The city prioritizes safety with low crime rates and outstanding emergency services, ensuring peace of mind for residents.

San Marcos is also dedicated to enhancing community well-being, with 60 miles of trails, 29 parks, and 11 recreation centers developed in the past 25 years. Popular spots like Creekside Marketplace, Nordahl Center, and Grand Plaza provide convenient shopping and dining options right in town. These amenities, along with its welcoming atmosphere, make San Marcos a unique and appealing community for students and residents alike.



NORTH COUNTY

What locals call “North County” is the area north of downtown San Diego and its central communities that offers a diverse blend of suburban living and coastal charm, spanning about 20 miles along U.S. Highway 101 and Interstate 5.

North San Diego County offers a wealth of activities for foodies, shoppers, outdoor enthusiasts, and families alike. Start by exploring its diverse beach towns, each with its own unique charm. Del Mar is famed for its seasonal racetrack and upscale beach village, while Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve offers stunning hiking trails with rare Torrey pine trees and panoramic ocean views.



Head north to Solana Beach for excellent tide-pooling at Fletcher Cove and eclectic boutiques on Cedros Avenue. Cardiff-by-the-Sea boasts a beach campground, gourmet market, and the iconic Cardiff Kook statue, perfect for surfers and beachgoers. Encinitas, known for its surf breaks and meditation gardens, features a funky downtown lined with boutiques. Nearby Carlsbad offers a coastal village atmosphere with attractions like LEGOLAND California and the colorful Flower Fields.

Oceanside has become a hub for beach activities, water sports, and public art, including vibrant murals. For nature lovers, hike to waterfalls at Los Peñasquitos Canyon Preserve or strike a pose at the Instagram-famous “Potato Chip Rock” near Poway. Encinitas hosts the San Diego Botanic Garden and Butterfly Farms, while Vista boasts the Alta Vista Botanical Gardens. Escondido offers wildlife watching and safari rides at the expansive San Diego Zoo Safari Park.

DISCOVER YOUR DREAMS ON THE WEST COAST

California State University San Marcos is ideally located on the vibrant West Coast. Whether you want to experience a live music performance or play sand volleyball on one of our iconic beaches, you're just minutes away from it all.

SAN DIEGO

With museums, art galleries dining and shops, the walkable Old Town San Diego is a popular destination. The Old Town State Historic Park shows what life was like in California for Mexicans and early Americans.

With 15 museums, multiple live performance venues, gardens, and many other cultural and recreational attractions, the historic Balboa Park makes a great destination. The largest urban cultural park in the nation is also home to the San Diego Zoo.

Established in 1798, Mission San Luis Rey, an architectural and cultural historic landmark featuring an interpretive museum, located 15 minutes from campus, is one of the oldest in California, and the largest of the 22 missions in the state.

OUTDOOR LIFE

San Diego's North County provides endless opportunities for students to enjoy the natural beauty of Southern California.

Surfing, sand volleyball, and other sun activities take place just minutes from campus at one of the nearby beaches in Oceanside, Carlsbad, and Encinitas. Just off campus, enjoy one of the City of San Marcos' extensive walking and hiking trails. From the top of Double Peak Park hiking trail, you can see the Pacific Ocean and a great aerial view of CSUSM.

Explore the rugged beauty of the nearly 2,000 acre Palomar Mountain State Park for wildlife sightings and a breath of fresh mountain air.

Snowboarding and skiing are less than two hours away at Southern California's premier winter escape in Big Bear and Snow Valley.

The Campus Recreation department provides a variety of outdoor adventures for students, from bungee jumping and paintball to week-long wilderness explorations.



CALIFORNIA CENTER FOR THE ARTS

California Center for the Arts is the cultural center of North San Diego County and close to CSUSM in Escondido.

GETTING AROUND

If you don't have access to a car or if you prefer the ease of mass transit, two options can help you get to and from CSUSM and the surrounding area: the BREEZE bus system and the SPRINTER rail system.







Breeze

The BREEZE is North San Diego County's bus system. With numerous routes to and from neighborhoods and destinations all around San Diego County, the BREEZE provides access to Cal State San Marcos and surrounding locations.

Sprinter

A modern light-rail system, the SPRINTER runs from Escondido to Oceanside with a stop on-campus at CSUSM and is a great option for getting around North San Diego County. Once you arrive at the CSUSM station, a BREEZE bus services the university with a stop at Craven Circle near the center of the campus.
