PERSONAL SUPPORT

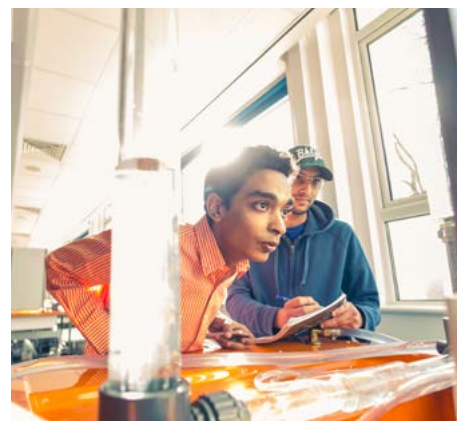

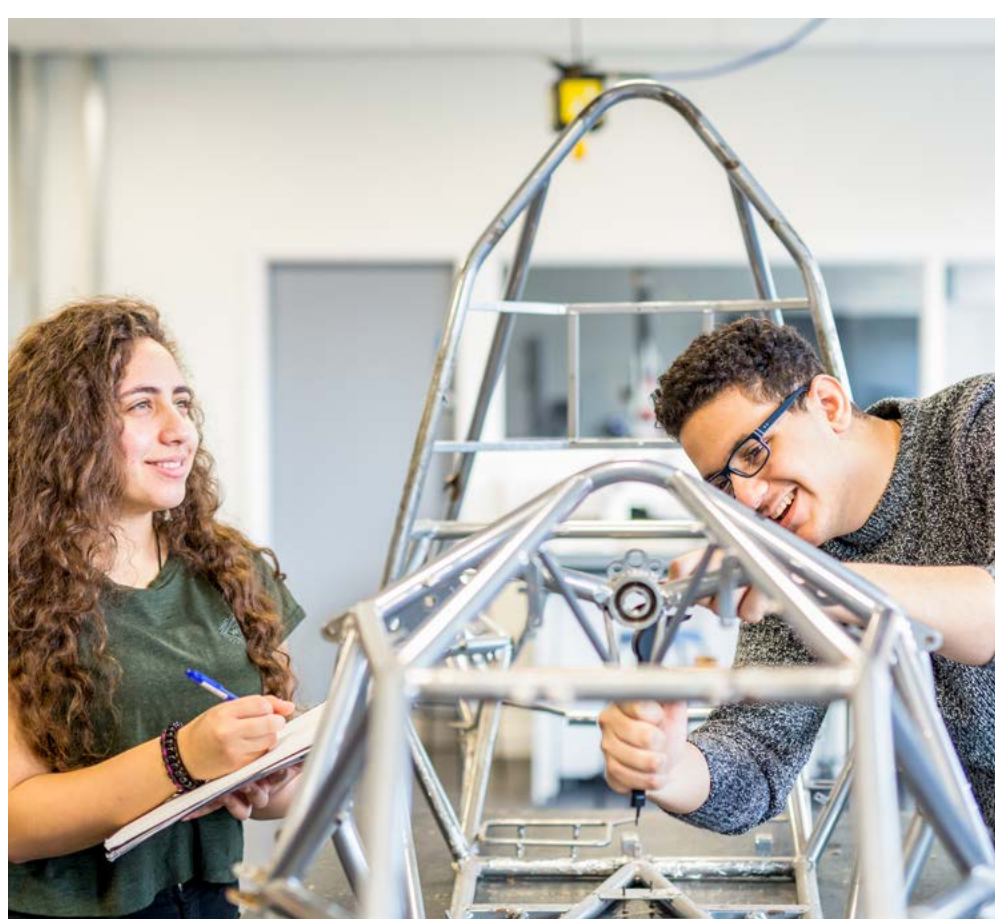
If you are holding a conditional offer from LJMU and one of the conditions is to improve your English score, then this course is ideal for you.
