### Report for newsletter from meeting of Parish Leadership Team, 11<sup>th</sup> October.

Reflection on our journey: The PLT commenced its work in June 2013. Members of the team spent time reflecting on and discussing our progress and achievements in service of the parish throughout this time. Much has been achieved but there are still many challenges and opportunities to explore. Many things were noted but the most significant was the building of a sense of unity and identity under our banner of Christ the Light Parish, and the development of our Vision and Mission Statement.

Future planning: Over the next few meetings we will be considering the role of the PLT and our priorities as a parish for the next three years. A significant priority will of course be the answering of our prayers for a new church building at Doreen.

Parish community celebrations program: The team endorsed a proposal from Fr Hien to develop an annual parish community celebrations program which will include liturgical and social celebrations as well as a variety of parish gatherings and activities.
