PROFESSOR RICK VALENTA

Acting Institute Director, Sustainable Minerals Institute, University of Queensland

Future mineral supply, the focus on critical minerals and challenges for the industry in NSW

Professor Rick Valenta has over 40 years in the mining industry and related research. His 25 years in industry have included CEO and COO roles in four Australian and Canadian resource companies, where he has led teams that have discovered and put into production significant deposits of gold, copper and uranium. Throughout his career he has had senior technical and executive roles that have placed him at the interface of the commercial, technical and strategic aspects of the business and innovation ecosystem of future mineral supply.

Rick is the current Acting Institute Director of The University of Queensland Sustainable Minerals Institute (SMI). During his past 5 years at SMI, Rick has led impactful programs including the Complex Orebodies Program, and more recently played a key role in the \$120m Resource Technology and Critical Minerals Trailblazer as well as a recent SMI-led initiative in Resourcing Decarbonisation.
