## THE CITY

Concord's story begins with a spirited disagreement between German and Scots-Irish settlers over the location of Cabarrus County's seat. Following the area's settlement in the 1750s, tensions ran high, but by 1796, the two sides reached a compromise. The result was the founding of "Concord," aptly named to symbolize their newfound harmony. The city took root on a 26-acre site and has flourished ever since.

Today, much of Concord's charm lies in its Historic Downtown, where historic architecture meets modern boutiques, restaurants, and cultural attractions.

### Passport/Visa



Citizens of Schengen Area countries, along with Andorra, Australia, Brunei, Canada, Ireland, Japan, Monaco, New Zealand, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, and the United Kingdom, can visit the United States for up to 90

days without needing a visa, provided they obtain an approved ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) before their trip. All other travelers must secure a visa before visiting the U.S.

In addition, international travelers must ensure their passport is valid for at least six months beyond their intended stay. For the most current information and any updates on entry requirements, it is advisable to consult the U.S. Department of State website or contact the nearest U.S. embassy or consulate before traveling.

### Time Zone



Concord is located in the Eastern Time Zone (ET), which is 5 hours behind Coordinated Universal Time (UTC-5). During daylight saving time, observed from early March to early November, the region shifts to UTC-4.

### Public Transport



Public transportation in Concord, North Carolina, is somewhat limited, with the primary option being the Concord Kannapolis Area Transit (CK Rider) bus system. The service operates on a few routes that connect different areas within the city, as well as neighboring towns like Kannapolis. However, the system is not as extensive as in larger cities, and it may not be the most convenient option for tourists looking to explore

all of Concord's attractions. For visitors, renting a car, using ride-sharing services like Uber or Lyft, or relying on taxis might be more efficient.

If you're planning to use public transit, it's good to check the schedules in advance, as the service runs on limited routes and hours.
