ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES

**FINAL**

In addition to the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition on The R&A Hard Card, the following Local Rules and Conditions will apply to The R&A Girls and Boys Home Internationals to be played at Lindrick Golf Club from 08–10 August 2023.

1. **Out of bounds (18.2):**

- Beyond any fence, wall or hedge defining a boundary of the course.
- On or over the tarmac areas around the clubhouse and the car park.
- In or beyond the edge of the flower beds and shale borders at the back of 18<sup>th</sup> green and practice putting greens.
- On or over the road to the 14<sup>th</sup> green and 15<sup>th</sup> tee.
- Areas inside tunnels defined by a white line directly below the boundary fence.

2. **Penalty Area**

The stream at the back of the 4<sup>th</sup> green and in front of the 5<sup>th</sup> tee has been marked as a Red Penalty Area. If a ball is in the Penalty Area (including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the Penalty Area) the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:

- a. Take relief under 17.1 or as an extra option
- b. Drop a ball in the nearest Drop Zone (R14.3) to where the ball entered the Penalty Area

The quarry to the left of Hole 16 is a Red Penalty Area.

3. **Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1)**

All artificial paths are immovable obstructions.

4. **Integral Objects**

All walls are integral parts of the course and the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable.

5. **Wrong Green (Rule 13.1f)**

- The temporary green on the 4<sup>th</sup> hole is a temporary green. Relief MUST be taken.

6. **Status of Yellow with Green Tops or Green Posts/Stakes**

- At various locations on the course, there are yellow posts/stakes. These indicate and are in reference to public footpaths only and have no other meaning (i.e. they do NOT define a Yellow penalty area).

7. **Drainage Lines on Hole 1 (HCLR 3a(5))**

- Drainage lines across the 1<sup>st</sup> fairway are to be treated as per HCLR 3a (5), i.e. relief for lie of the ball and intended swing only.
8. **Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs)**
- a. TIOs include, but are not limited to scoreboard, tents, advertising boards, temporary toilets and Clocks
  - b. *Relief on Either Side from all TIOs:*
    - i. *If a player is allowed relief from a TIO, the player may take relief on either side of the TIO. But either side relief is not allowed if the player chooses to operate under 16.1.*

Penalty for breach of local rule: Loss of Hole in Match play
