THE JUNIOR VAGLIANO TROPHY

ROYAL DORNOCH – CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE 30 JUNE – 1 JULY 2023

In addition to the Local Rules and Terms of Competition on The R&A Hard Card, the following Local Rules and Terms of Competition will apply to The Vagliano Trophy and The Junior Vagliano Trophy Matches on 30 June and 1 July.

1. 1st Tee

For the purposes of Rule 5.3a, the 1st teeing area is deemed to be the portion of the championship tee cut to tee height.

2. Out of Bounds ([Rule 18.2](#))

a) Beyond any wall or fence defining the boundary of the course.

Note: At hole 8, the inner fence is the boundary.

b) At hole 2, the boundary is defined by the wall, then the white line, then the fence.

c) The Clubhouse, Professional's shop, Car park and the surrounding paved area, including the steps leading to the neighbouring hotel, are out of bounds. The boundary is partly defined by a line of white posts, partly by a dotted white line, and partly by the course-side concrete edge of the paving.

3. Abnormal Course Conditions (Including Immovable Obstructions) ([Rule 16](#))

a) Artificially-surfaced roads and paths (including rubber paths) and artificial edgings.

Note: all natural paths are integral parts of the course (see point 4a below)

b) Stiles in boundary fences or walls.

c) Refreshment bins, drinking fountains, and other fixed course furniture, including the concrete bases.

d) Concrete bases of bench seats. (the bench seats themselves are movable obstructions. See 5. below)

e) Steps to teeing areas.

f) All shelters and other permanent structures on the course.

g) At hole 16, the wooden posts and metal sign adjacent to the road.

h) At holes 1 and 18, the bollards lining the road.

i) White lined area left of the 7th fairway

4. Integral Objects

a) Natural paths.

b) Gates in boundary fences.

5. Temporary Immovable Obstructions (TIOs)

Multiple Obstructions Deemed to be One TIO

a) Where there are multiple TIOs, these are deemed to be one TIO.

Relief on Either Side

A player may take relief from TIOs in accordance with Model Local Rule F-23. Either side relief is available for all TIO's except if the player is taking relief under Rule 16.1

6. Advice Giver

MLR H-2 Applies:

Each team may have one advice giver whom players on the team may ask for advice and receive advice from during the round. The team must identify each advice giver to the Committee before any player on the team begins their round. The team may change its advice giver during the round, but must tell the Committee when it is doing so. The advice giver must not point out a line of play or walk onto the putting green when the ball of the team player lies on the putting green.

Penalty for breach of Local Rule H-2 – General Penalty under Rule 10.2
