Conditions of Play:

The championship will feature a maximum field of 86 players comprised of the top female amateur golfers in the Asia-Pacific region represented by APGC Members and R&A affiliated national associations. The competition will consist of 72 holes stroke play over 4 days with a cut to the low 50 and ties. In the event of a tie for first place, a "Hole-by-Hole play-off will take place over the 18th Hole.

Consulate Contact Information: Should you require assistance from your home nation's Consulate Office, please contact or visit an official at the Championship office.

Credentials: All players will receive a commemorative money clip that will function as their credentials. These will provide a player allaccess to dining and practice facilities. Please keep your credential visible at all times.

All questions or problems regarding credentials can be handled by visiting or calling The Championship Office at the Siam Country Club Waterside.

Event Facts:

The Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific (WAAP) was created in July 2017 as a joint initiative of the Asia-Pacific Golf Confederation and the R&A. The winner shall be the Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific champion and receive the Rae-Vadee T. Suwan Champion's Medal. The winner will also receive an invitation to compete in the following events provided she is an amateur at the time of and throughout the respective event:

- 2023 AIG Women's Open
- 2023 The Amundi Evian Championship
- 2023 Augusta National Women's Amateur
- 2023 Hana Financial Group Championship

The leading runner-up will receive a place in the Final Qualifying stage of the 2023 AIG Women's Open. Ties will be decided in favour of the highest ranked player in WAGR at the commencement of the championship. She must be an amateur at the time of and throughout the event.

Incidentals: All incidentals (spa, mini bar, laundry etc) charged to a room will be at the guest's expense.

Internet Services: All guests will enjoy complimentary wireless internet services at Siam Country Club Waterside and Movenpick Siam Na Jomtien Pattaya.

Anti-doping

All players are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Details of the Policy, and the current List of Prohibited Substances and Methods, are available at International Golf Federation's website (www.igf.com). Players who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from The R&A or the IGF knowing that, should a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) be required, this must be submitted to the IGF not later than 30 days before the start of the Championship. Any further information about this Policy or antidoping in general can be obtained representatives of the Championship Committee.

Behavior

The R&A requires players and their team to conduct themselves in a manner that is respectful of the Championship and the sport of golf. Players and their team, shall at all times, act in the best interests of the sport and the Championship, and shall not conduct themselves in an unlawful or improper manner, so as to bring the Championship, The R&A, the sport of golf or its governing bodies into disrepute and shall not use any one of or a combination of, violent conduct, threatening, abusive, indecent or insulting words or behavior. Players and their team shall comply with any Code of Conduct set by the Committee from time to time. For the purposes of this condition, a player's team includes their caddies as well as any agents, coaches or other support team including family members present at the Championship or in the environs of the Championship venue or otherwise acting in relation to the Championship. If a competitor acts contrary to the spirit of the game, the Committee will take appropriate action which may include reporting the facts to the competitor's Federation or National Golf Association. If the competitor is considered to have committed serious misconduct the competitor may be disqualified.

Caddie Information and Guidelines

Players may use a caddie; however, the caddie will be at the players' expense. A player, shall at all times be liable for the actions of her caddie and shall ensure that the caddie complies with the Terms as they apply to her.

A player shall ensure that her caddie wears clothing of a golf type appropriate to the Championship and, in particular, a caddie shall be required to wear a Championship over-garment or bib of a type and design as shall be supplied by the Championship Committee. Caddies will be required to wear such an over-garment or bib during official practice rounds and during the Championship.

Caddies must not wear shoes with metal spikes.

Local caddies will be available to assist players during the tournament week at a rate of a minimum of 900thb is to be paid to the caddie for their services with a maximum 18holes or less per round. It is encouraged for the player to provide the caddie with a tip.

Distance-Measuring Devices

Distance-Measuring Devices are allowed in accordance with Rule 4.3a(1) in the Rules of Golf.

Returning of Score Cards

A player's card is deemed officially returned when the player has left the recording area.

Close of Competition

The competition is deemed to have closed when the Trophy has been presented to the winner at the Trophy Presentation.

Equipment Needs and Repair

There will be no club fitting or repair service provided.

Format

The Championship shall be played at Siam Country Club Waterside, Thailand.

Round 1: Thursday, 3rd November Round 2: Friday, 4th November Round 3: Saturday, 5th November Round 4: Sunday, 6th November

One round of 18 holes shall be played on each of the first two days for which one draw shall be made. The players returning the 50 lowest scores, and anyone tying for 50th place over the first 36 holes shall qualify for the final 36 holes over the last two days. For the final 36 holes, the pairings and starting times shall be determined in accordance with the qualifying scores, players with the lowest scores starting last.

In the event of a tie for the Championship after four rounds, the players who tie shall play a hole-by-hole play-off to determine the Champion. Terms of the play-off will be posted on the Championship notice board during the event and will be available on request.

Gender

Players must be of the female gender and have been female at birth or have had the female gender assigned. For the avoidance of doubt, The Championship Committee reserves the right to carry out a confidential case-by-case evaluation at any time either prior to or after the Championship if in its reasonable opinion such an evaluation is or becomes necessary. Any player in breach of this term may be disqualified.

All players are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Details of the Policy, and the current List of Prohibited Substances and Methods, are available from the International Golf Federation's website **Players** (www.igfgolf.org). who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from The R&A or the IGF knowing that, should a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) be required this must be submitted to the IGF not later than 30 days before the start of the Championship.

Driver Heads, Groove Specifications and Conforming Balls

The Model Local Rules in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf are in effect regarding Conforming Driver Heads, Conforming Golf Balls and Groove and Punch Mark Specifications.

Note: It is strongly recommended that any player in doubt as to whether their equipment conforms to these Local Rules consult with the Championship Committee. This should be done as far in advance of the Championship as possible. Conforming lists are available at: www.randa.org.

Groupings/Starting Times

During the first and second rounds, the field shall be groups of three and teed off from the 1st tees. For the third and fourth rounds, the field shall be regrouped based on scores, groups of three and started from the 1st tees. The Championship Committee may however, at its discretion, choose to alter these arrangements. Following the second round, after all scores are verified, the cut will be made, and groupings will be determined by score.

Media Release

R&A Championships Limited seeks media coverage and publicity for the Women's Amateur Asia Pacific around and during the Championship via both the written press and via broadcast and audio-visual media. Each player by entering the Championship and by agreeing to these Terms assigns to R&A Championships Limited and its assignees and licensees the right in perpetuity throughout the world to make, use, edit, exhibit and reproduce (and to authorise others to do so) in any and all media (whether Press, radio, television, internet or otherwise), whether now known or hereafter devised for commercial and/or other purposes from time to time and at their discretion, any and all pictures, coverage, recordings and any other reproductions of any description of the player made during or in connection with the Championship (including, without limitation, during practice and play) without compensation for the player or the heirs, successors, executors, administrators or assignees of the player. The player also assigns the right to use and reproduce their name, voice, likeness and biographical material in any way now known or hereafter devised by R&A Championships Limited for the purpose of promoting the Championship and any subsequent Championships, without compensation for the player or the heirs, successors, executors, administrators or assignees of the player including in circumstances where it may include the logo of a third party or of a sponsor or patron of the Championship or any subsequent Championship or any other activities undertaken by R&A Championships Limited. Players shall be responsible for ensuring that their caddies (if applicable) will assign to R&A Championships Limited and its successors and licensees equivalent rights in relation to the caddie.

Notwithstanding the foregoing grant of rights, R&A Championships Limited and its assignees and licensees agree that, other than as permitted above, they will not authorise any company contractually associated with R&A Championships Limited to use the player's name, voice, likeness and biographical material in a way which constitutes the endorsement of a product or service, without first requiring such associated company to obtain the player's authorisation. R&A Championships Limited may also use any image of the player taken at the Championship to populate the relevant pages of the WORLD AMATEUR GOLF RANKING™ website at www.wagr.com.

Transportation

Model Local Rule G-6 is in effect. A player or caddie must not ride on any form of motorised transportation except as authorised or later approved by the Committee. The R&A will only consider requests for use of motorised transportation where:

- 1. the player making the request has a qualifying disability and
- 2. the need for transportation results from that disability.

Any requests by a player to use any form of transportation must be made by close of entries. All requests must be made in accordance with the procedures outlined in The R&A's Transportation Policy, available on request from The R&A.

Pace of Play (Rule 5.6)

See separate memorandum to players for the pace of play policy.

Suspension of Play (Rule 5.7b)

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by one prolonged airhorn note. All other types of suspension will be signalled by three consecutive airhorn notes, repeated. Resumption of play will be signalled by two short airhorn notes, repeated.

Prohibiting Practising on or Near Previous Putting Green

Between the play of two holes, a player must not make any practice stroke on or near the putting green of the hole just completed, or test the surface of that putting green by rubbing the putting green or rolling a ball. Model Local Rule 1-2 from the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf is in effect.

Practice Facilities

Range balls are supplied free of charge, compliments of the Women's Amateur Asia-Pacific. Below are the Practice Range hours:

Monday – Saturday 06:00-18:00 Sunday 06:00-10:30

Short Game Practice facilities will be located at the Driving Range. Practice Putting green will be located at the front of the Clubhouse and 1st tee.

Practice Round Starting Times

Practice Rounds will be played on Tuesday 1st and Wednesday 2nd November.

Pre-assigned tee times will be available by the Championship Office. All times will be available at Player Registration. Flight arrival times will be considered when determining practice times.

Rules of Play

The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.

1.The Model Local Rules in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf are in effect regarding Conforming Driver Heads, Conforming Golf Balls and Groove and Punch Mark Specifications.

Note: It is strongly recommended that any player in doubt as to whether their equipment conforms to these Local Rules consult with the Championship Committee. This should be done as far in advance of the Championship as possible. Conforming lists are available at: www.randa.org.

- 2. Model Local Rule G-10 in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf is in effect. In making a stroke, the player must not use a club, except for a putter, which exceeds 46 inches in length.
- 3. All competitors are subject to the provisions of The R&A's Anti-Corruption and Betting Policy in force at the date of the Championship.
- 4. All competitors and/or caddies are subject to the provisions of The R&A's Logos and Marks Policy in force at the date of the Championship.
- 5. The Modified Rules for Players with Disabilities are in effect. To allow The R&A time to consider an application, a golfer who wishes to play under the Modified Rules should contact amateurentries@randa.org a minimum of two weeks in advance of the Championship, to advise of their wish to use the Modified Rules.

Authority

The Committee's objective is to complete the Championship as per the format outlined in these Terms of Competition. The Committee reserves the right to amend these Terms of Competition at any time before or during the Championship and/or cancel the Championship before or during play. The decision of the Committee is final in all matters.
