

My new novel, *Wonderscape*, is about thirteen-year-olds Arthur, Ren and Cecily, who after an encounter with some exploding garden gnomes get accidentally transported to the year 2473. They find themselves trapped inside the Wonderscape – a new kind of “video” game. It isn't played on a screen from the comfort of a sofa, but is played in reality. As they try to solve the mystery of how to get home, they must adventure through the game, completing challenges and meeting some of history's most extraordinary heroes. They include a genius scientist, fearless environmental campaigner, pioneering inventor, daring warrior, and a very famous author as you've never seen her before.

I've tried to write a story which allows young readers to immerse themselves in a magical, fast-paced and exciting world. The real heroes that populate the Wonderscape are all people whose stories have inspired me and by sharing their achievements, hopefully young readers will consider how much potential they have to put their own mark on history.

I hope that you will have as much fun reading this adventure as I had writing it.
