



Walker Books are delighted to announce the acquisition of a teen handbook by Nikki Lilly — YouTube sensation with over a million subscribers, presenter of her own CBBC show Nikki Lilly Meets, and winner of the 2016 Junior Bake Off. Executive Editorial Director Denise Johnstone Burt acquired World Rights, all languages, for one book via Blakeway North, producers of Nikki's CBBC content. The book, titled Nikki Lilly's Come on Life: Highs, Lows and How to Live Your Best Teen Life will publish in hardback priced at £12.99 in October 2020.

Nikki Lilly began her YouTube channel at the age of eight, after being diagnosed with a rare medical condition called an arteriovenous malformation (AVM), which means there are no pathways between her veins and arteries, causing her veins to expand and rupture. The condition creates life-threatening nose bleeds, facial swelling and migraines, but despite this Nikki has built a huge online following, thanks to her inspirational messages of positivity. As well as her YouTube videos, Nikki has her own CBBC series, *Nikki Lilly Meets*, in which she chats to some of the country's top celebs from Louis Theroux to Theresa May. In 2016, she won Junior Bake Off and was awarded the Child of Courage Award at Pride of Britain. In 2019, Nikki won an International Emmy Kids Award for her programme *My Life: Born to Vlog* and became the youngest ever recipient of the BAFTA Special Award.



From celebrated picture book creators Chris Raschka and Vladimir Radunsky comes one possible answer to the age-old question: Who was Mother Goose?



David McKee is the creator of well-known characters including King Rollo, Mr Benn and Elmer the Patchwork Elephant. His books are enjoyed by children all over the world.




"All aboard," the conductor cried out. I ran up to him.

"Why, to the North Pole of course," was his answer. "This is the Polar Express." I took his outstretched hand and he pulled me aboard.




