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The Events Centre Box Office, Caloundra




The Events Centre Caloundra is the Sunshine Coast's premier performing arts & conference centre.

To improve user functionality and provide access to the box office when the building may be otherwise closed, a need was identified by Council to create a new box office towards the front of the foyer that would provide external access to patrons via the courtyard window to purchase tickets or make enquiries without the need to enter the building.

Roof Replacement - Caloundra Indoor Stadium

The stadium roof has reached end of service life and as a result, the entire stadium main roof including lower south roof are being replaced, which is an area of approximately 4,500m².

Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade (CTCU)



The CTCU will connect Caloundra's business centre and Omrah Avenue to Nicklin Way via a 1.6 kilometre-long active transport and road corridor. The CTCU Project Team comprises the Queensland Government's Department of Transport and Main Roads and Sunshine Coast Council. The project is jointly funded by the Australian Government, Queensland Government and Sunshine Coast Council.

Highly experienced, local engineering firm, Aurecon is completing the CTCU detailed design. Design work includes reviewing some sections of the project with consideration of community feedback received by the project team.

Detailed design completion is expected by late 2023 with early works and construction to follow shortly after.

Sportsman Parade DDA Pathways Link, Bokarina



The aim of the project is to connect the existing pathways to make it accessible for everyone, as there are currently two missing connections.

The end result will be interconnected pathways that provide improved access and connectivity for the community.


Charles Clarke Park Sewall Reconstruction, Mooloolaba


Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade – Stage 4

Parkyn Parade, Mooloolaba – Footpath Renewal



Parkyn Parade footpath renewal is being widened from 1.8m to 3m to meet the growing needs of off-street cyclists and pedestrians. The new shared pathway will be offset from the back of kerb by 1.2m to provide buffer between parked cars and pathway users.

Detailed design has commenced for a site at River Markets, Bli Bli and a transportable module that can be trucked to various locations, then quickly assembled and ready for public use.

The module will have site specific features as necessary and be as self-sufficient as possible using sustainable technology. It will also form a meeting place for the public as well as providing library services.

Nambour (Namba) Place Revitalisation Project – community workshop #2

Planning is under way for the Nambour's revitalisation! Council is now working with an external consultant to develop a concept plan (Namba Place Plan) for the main active frontages of the major centre.

Two community workshops were run to ensure the project scope and outcomes align with previous planning, and to ensure we are on track as we progress. The energy and enthusiasm shown by Cr. David Law, Rob Skelton MP, and key community and council representatives was inspiring and a great indication of how ready the town is for potential change.


Accessibility Improvements funding



The accessibility fund is intended to help make the Sunshine Coast and its lifestyle more accessible to people with restrictions and to help increase inclusivity.

This financial year, the fund was able to support 8 projects across the region:

- 4 construction projects (pathway links, pedestrian paths and kerb ramps)
- 2 mapping projects (activity trail and Briometrix mapping)
- 1 facility extension (additional beach mats and a beach trolley)
- 1 planning and design project (all abilities playground)

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Brisbane Road Upgrade - Mooloolaba Transport Corridor Upgrade

Works on the new bridge are progressing well with an anticipated completion of late May. This date will coincide with the final road resurfacing and landscaping of Stage 2 and 3. There will be some final works following this on the downstream of the bridge with the boardwalk construction. This is expected to be completed in August.



Woombye – Blackall Street, Streetscape Placemaking

Construction works are near completion on the Blackall Street, Woombye streetscape project. Works include footpath, road works and landscaping from the Woombye School of Arts hall down the street towards Frankie's Café. Also the construction of a new raised crossing between School of Arts and Woombye Rural Supplies is in progress. This project is being delivered as part of Council's streetscape capital works program and is jointly funded by the Queensland Government.



Revetment Wall & Car Park Upgrade – Maroochydore Cod Hole Boat Ramp

Reconstruction of the revetment wall and tie in with existing boat ramp, upgrade of the car park area, construction of bridging slab with screw piers for the protection of Unitywater assets. Works are expected to be completed mid-May 2023.



Nambour – Bade Street, Retaining Wall Replacement

A seventy-metre section of mass rock retaining wall located along Bade Street is being removed and replaced. This will provide a durable and long-lasting structural solution. Works are expected to be completed May 2023.

4. Follow procedures and instructions.
5. Check all plant & equipment and be competent in its use.
6. Use and maintain correct PPE.
7. Report all hazards, incidents and near misses.

The decisions we make at work affect our lives outside of work, so it is within your own interests, as well of those of your employer, to follow the 7 Safety Essentials.
