Finding housing independently

Studying in Amsterdam can be a rewarding experience. However, finding student housing can be challenging given the current housing situation. You should be aware that finding housing is difficult here, and therefore, your search may not be successful. We do want to help you succeed, so below you can find some useful websites and platforms for finding student housing.

To give you an idea of the pricing and waiting times for these different platforms, we have indicated the average rental price range and waiting times with euro and clock signs. You can find the legend below. Registration fees refer to the one-time fee you would have to pay to register on the platform. Some platforms also ask for a booking fee after you successfully find housing through their service.

International students get priority through ROOM's priority ruling. This means that finding housing through ROOM may take up less than the initially indicated waiting time. Therefore, signing up to ROOM is still recommended.

If you are planning to study in the Netherlands for multiple years, ROOM.nl offers campus contracts that cover housing for the whole duration of your study. However, keep in mind there might still be very long waiting times.

Please note that via our service you will be making use of ROOM University Housing. This is a special platform and different from the regular ROOM.nl. The houses that are offered on ROOM University Housing are not offered on the regular ROOM.nl.

Maximum stay of 5 years for ages 18-28, maximum stay of 2 years for ages 28 and older. Please note that there are often income requirements.
