



BED BUG CHEMICAL TREATMENT PREP LIST

The following things must be done PRIOR to our arrival time:

1. Launder clothing, bedding & curtains on high heat for a minimum of 45 minutes. Bag all clothing in plastic bags. Curtains should also be bagged until after treatment.
2. Pull all furniture away from the wall about a foot.
3. Keep all clothing and other items out of dressers for treatments
4. Do not pile anything on beds or other furniture.

On the day of the treatment

1. Please be ready to leave as soon as the technician arrives. This ensures that they are on schedule and not rushed leaving them to do a more thorough job.
2. You **MUST** be out of the building for at least **4 hours**. This includes all tenants and pets.
3. Have beds stripped – any bedding that hasn't already been laundered prior to our arrival should be done while you are out of the building.
4. Upon returning, vacuum beds, floors and other furniture when you return.
5. Be prepared to put beds back together (mattress & box spring will not be on the frame). If you are unable to do this, notify the technician as they arrive.
6. The technician will lock the door when they leave unless told otherwise by occupant.

Tenants that do not complete the prep list, refuse to leave the day of the treatment or are more than 15 minutes late for their scheduled appointment are subject to a \$50.00 fee for Bug Busterzzz having to make a second trip.

What to expect after treatment:

- ❖ Bed Bugs will still be active after the first trip. This is OK. We will be back in 2 weeks to repeat this process.
- ❖ After a few days, you should see a decrease in activity.
- ❖ Sometimes the material will make the Bed Bugs move and you may see more during the day than usual. This is normal.
