Flagship Journals in the e-Duke Journals Collection

- ***American Literature*** – Regarded since its inception as the preeminent periodical in its field, this journal contains articles covering the works of American authors from colonial to contemporary.
- ***Comparative Literature*** – The oldest U.S. journal in its field, featuring cutting-edge research that explores intersections among national literatures, global literary trends, and theoretical discourse.
- ***GLQ: A Journal of Lesbian and Gay Studies*** – Providing a much-needed forum for interdisciplinary discussion, *GLQ* publishes scholarship, criticism, and commentary on sex and sexuality in areas as diverse as law, science studies, religion, political science, and literary studies.
- ***Hispanic American Historical Review*** – This journal pioneered the study of Latin American history and culture in the United States and remains the most widely respected journal in the field.
