PUBLICATION AGREEMENT FOR DUKE UNIVERSITY PRESS JOURNALS

(Note: Production work cannot begin until each author has signed and returned this form.)

From: _____ (Editor), acting for the Population Association of America (“the Sponsor”) and in conjunction with Duke University Press (“the Publisher”).

We are pleased to have accepted for publication in *Demography* your article entitled

The Author guarantees that the article contains no matter that can be construed as libelous or as infringing in any way on the copyright of another party, and that they will defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Sponsor and Publisher against all suits, proceedings, or claims that may be taken on the grounds that said article is in such violation.

Copyright will be in the name of the Author, and the Author will assume any responsibility for registering the article’s copyright with the U.S. Copyright Office. The Publisher will, however, register copyright on the entire serial issue of which the article is a part.

The Author hereby grants and assigns to the Sponsor the exclusive right, for the full term of all rights including copyrights, to publish the work and derivatives thereof in all media and geographic territories, including the sole rights to publish and license selections, expansions, and abridgements thereof.

If the article is ultimately published and tagged as open access, it will carry a Creative Commons license of BY-NC-ND (allowing noncommercial reuse only, with attribution required, and no creation of derivative works without permission). Instead of the rights in the preceding paragraph, the Author will grant the Sponsor exclusive rights for first publication of the article in English, and the following rights in regard to the article: to quote from the article in any promotional material on behalf of the journal; to photocopy the article for its own use; to republish the article in any future reprintings of the journal issue; to republish the article in any books or other collections gathered from the same journal; to grant permission to others for reproduction of the entire issue in which the article is contained, in all formats, including microfilm and electronic storage; the nonexclusive right to grant permission to others for photocopying, electronic reproduction, and transmission of the article; the nonexclusive right to authorize republication of the article in anthologies, the nonexclusive right to publish and have published foreign language translations of the article for anthologies; and the nonexclusive right to use and distribute, and allow others to use and distribute, translated quotations and excerpts of the article in works published in foreign languages. The Author will retain all other rights.

All parties agree that the Author has the following rights in any event: to make and distribute copies of the article in the course of teaching and research; to quote from the article in any book or article that they may later write; to photocopy the article for their own use, including in their own classes; and to post their accepted article manuscript (AAM) noncommercially, without embargo, on their personal website, in their university repository, and in other nonprofit or governmental open access repositories, with copyright and source information provided along with a link to the published version as soon as it is available. Where required by their funder or institution, the Author may also apply a Creative Commons license of BY (attribution required) to the AAM. Finally, the Author may also republish the article in any book they may write or edit after the journal has appeared. In case of republication, notice of previous publication in *Demography*, and that it is republished by permission of the Publisher, Duke University Press, must be given.

The (corresponding) Author will be given an opportunity, and a reasonable amount of time, to read and correct either the edited manuscript or proofs, depending on the journal’s customary procedure. If these are not returned to the Editor or the Publisher by the date specified, then production and publication may proceed without the Author’s corrections. For diagrams or illustrations used in the article, the Author agrees to furnish digital files satisfactory to the Publisher’s production

department. In addition, the Author agrees to be responsible for composition charges incurred when their changes made to typeset proofs affect, as an average, more than two lines per page.
