# Puerto Rico Department of Health

Chronic Disease Self-Management Education Program Grantee Profile, Fiscal Year 2024

#### Goals

This 4-year grant aims to:

- Develop capacity to increase the number of older adults and adults with disabilities who
  participate in evidence-based chronic disease self-management education (CDSME)
  programs and self-management support programs to empower them to better manage
  their chronic conditions.
- Identify and implement one or more robust strategies that will promote the sustainability of evidence-based self-management education and self-management support programs.

#### **Activities**

The grantee and its partners will:

- Form a CDSME advisory committee to enhance support for underserved older adults.
- Improve the technological infrastructure for remote program delivery.
- Develop a pilot project for referral and reimbursement.
- Train and certify 52 leaders in CDSME programs.
