

Comparison: Original Medicare, PACE, and integrated D-SNPs

If you have both Medicare and Medicaid, you are also known as “a dually eligible individual,” and you have several options for how you receive your coverage. The standard option is Original Medicare with separate Medicaid coverage. However, you can also choose the Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE). This program provides Medicare, Medicaid, and long-term care services under one plan. There are also types of Medicare Advantage Plans called Dual-eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNPs) that provide long-term care and/or behavioral health services (“integrated D-SNPs”).

- Original Medicare plus fee-for-service Medicaid is a good option for someone who wants a wider provider choice, or someone whose doctors are not in-network for any integrated care options.
- PACE may be a good option for individuals who want to receive their care through a single plan. PACE offers the possibility of greater care coordination at a center in your community.
- Integrated D-SNPs may be good options for individuals who want to receive their care through a single plan. They offer the possibility of greater care coordination and you may find these models preferable if you are accustomed to managed care and provider networks.

The table on the next page compares these three options for dually eligible individuals. Some options may have eligibility requirements for enrollment (such as a minimum age or requiring that you need a certain level of long-term care). If you are interested in joining a D-SNP, make sure to speak to a plan representative for more information.
