Chronic Disease Self-Management Education Program Grantee Profile, Fiscal Year 2024

Goals

This 4-year grant aims to:

- Expand training to help older adults with behavioral health (BH) conditions by participating in evidence-based programs.
- Decrease stigma with a 30% increase in positive attitudes toward seeking BH services or attending community programs.
- Mobilize 1,500 Community-Based Organizations (CBO) and Aging and Disability Services Network (ADSN) professionals trained to recognize, respond to, and refer older adults with behavioral health concerns.
- Assist 11,200 caregivers/family members of older adults educated on how to recognize, respond to, and refer older adults with behavioral health concerns.

Activities

The grantee and its partners will complete:

- Needs assessment and environmental scan.
- Stigma campaign with co-branded materials for CBO/ADSN organizations.
- Training program with 12 modules on how to recognize, respond, and refer older adults with behavioral health issues.
- Educational toolkits to support and enhance training program modules.
- Online resources hub, which includes a referral center, searchable database, and resource dictionary.
- Outreach toolkit that with help CBOs/ADSNs increase participation.

Outcomes

The grantee anticipates the following results from this project.

- Decrease stigma with a 30% increase in positive attitudes toward seeking BH services or attending community programs.
- Mobilize 1,500 CBO/ADSN professionals trained to recognize, respond to, and refer older adults with behavioral health concerns.
- Assist 11,200 caregivers/family members of older adults educated on how to recognize, respond to and refer older adults with behavioral health concerns. Engage with 438 participants in CDSMP, CPSMP, and DSMP at 90% completion rate.
- Engage with 460 participants in WWE.
- Increase the number of healthcare providers who participate in active bidirectional referral from 0 to 12.
- Work with a partnering organization to create a billing/reimbursement pathway.
