Research shows that compared to children without college savings, children with savings for college are:

- 3x more likely to enroll in college
- 5x more likely to graduate

Claim CalKIDS Account!

There are two types of CalKIDS College Savings Accounts:



At Birth Account

- \$25 initial deposit for all children born in California between July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023
- \$100 initial deposit for all children born in California after July 1, 2023
- Up to \$75 in additional incentives



School-Age Account

- \$500 for eligible low-income students
- Additional \$500 deposits for foster & homeless children

Eligibility for Low-Income Students

- Low-income public school students identified by the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) on Fall Academic Census Day are eligible
- LCFF eligibility generally includes:

Student receives meals through the National School Lunch Program

□Family submitted an Alternative Household Income Form

Student participates in CalFresh, CalWORKs, FDPIR (Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations), or Medi–Cal

□English learner status

□Migratory, homeless, and foster students

What is Needed to Claim a STUDENT account:



1. Statewide Student Identifier (SSID) <u>or</u> unique CalKIDS code found on the letter sent by mail

2. Student's date of birth

3. Name of the county where the student was enrolled on Fall Academic Census Day*

Academic Year	Grade	Fall Census Day	
2021 – 22	1 – 12	October 6, 2021	
2022 – 23	1	October 5, 2022	



*Fall Academic Census Day falls on the first Wednesday in October of the academic year. In subsequent years after 2021-22 academic year, only eligible 1st grade students are added each year.

What is Needed to Claim a Newborn Account:



1. Local Registration Number <u>or</u> unique CalKIDS code found on the letter sent by mail

2. Child's date of birth

3. Name of the county in which the child's birth was registered

Newborn awards will be processed within 90 days from the time the Board receives birth data from the California Department of Public Health.

Claim CalKIDS Account!



- Account may be claimed at any time.
- Funds can be used once a student is enrolled in an eligible college (including technical/vocational schools)
- Funds use for qualified higher education expenses (i.e. tuition, books, computer)
- Funds must be used before the age of 26.
