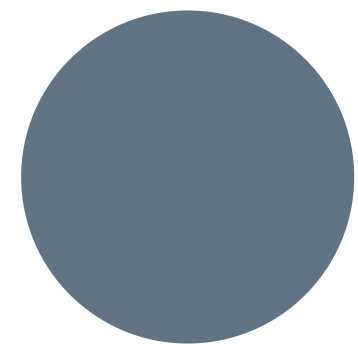




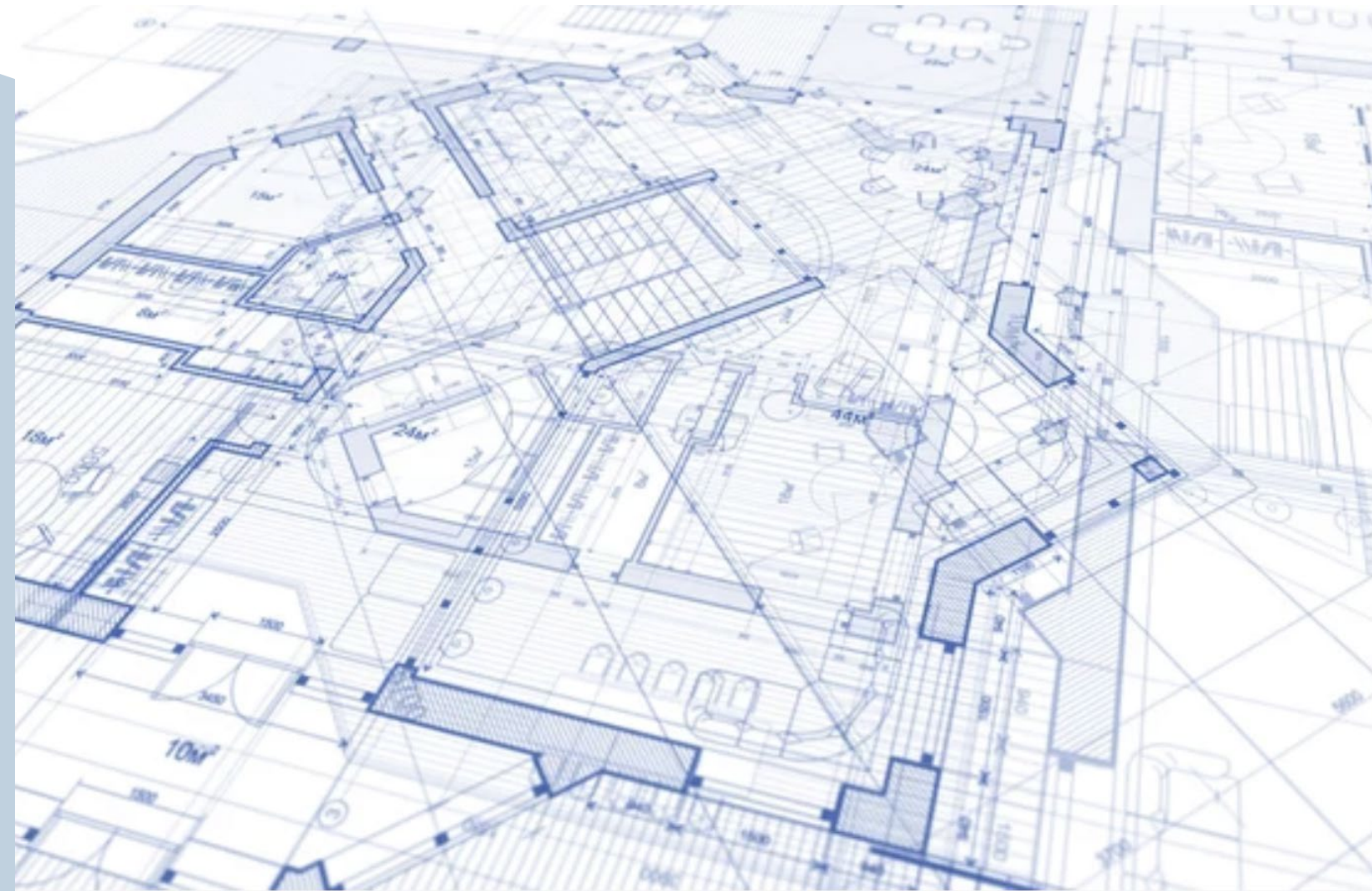

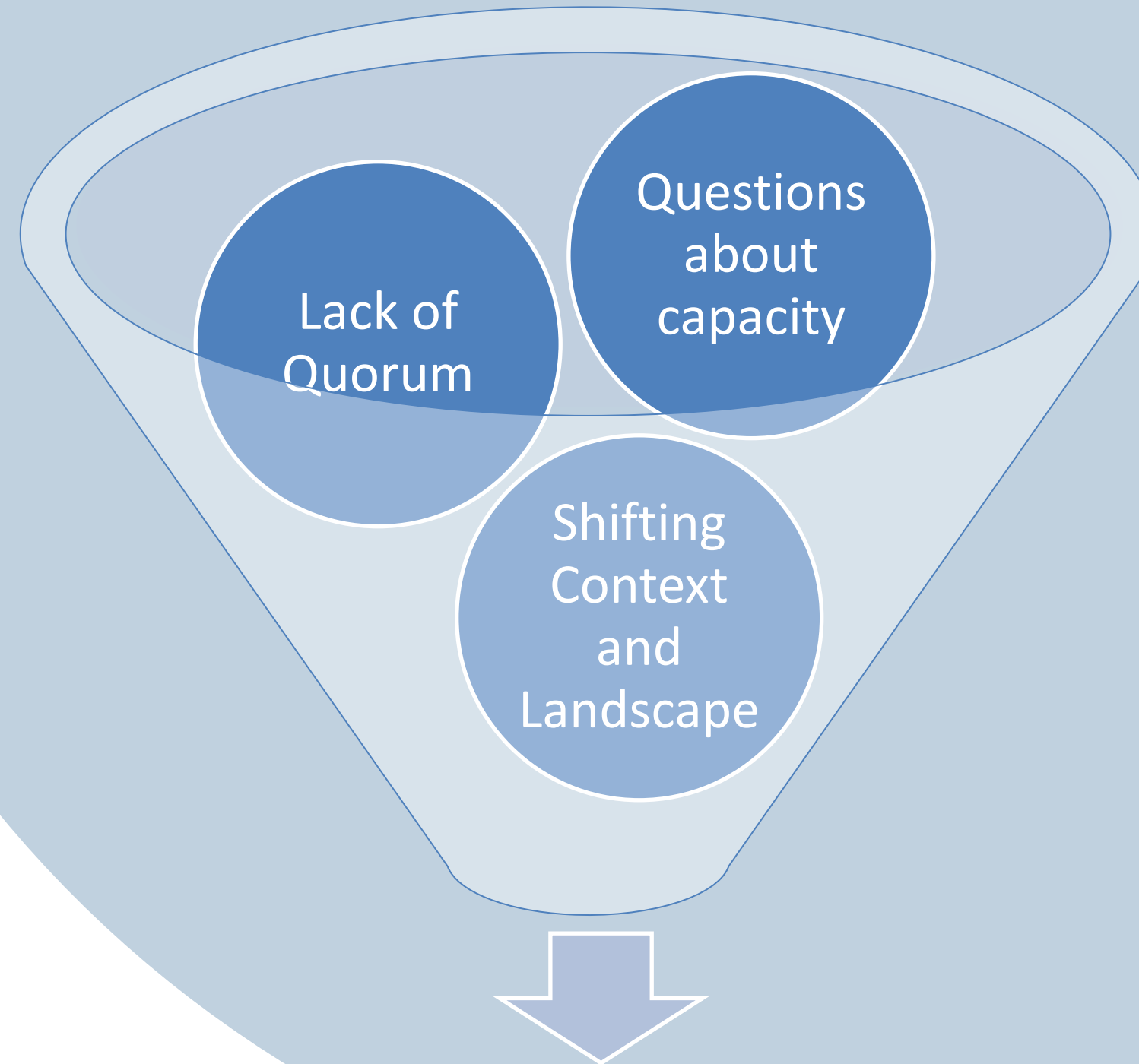

Factors Driving the Restructure



Current composition is **unsustainable** and needs to evolve with the demands of the HIV epidemic

PROJECT GOAL

- Identify the best structure and composition to have the most meaningful **impact** in the most **efficient** manner possible.

Steps We've Taken

Orientation & Communication

Introduced and oriented Commission members to restructuring project in December 2024

Regular updates provided

Focus Groups & Surveys

7 in-person and virtual focus groups – Discussed options for committee structure and number of required members.

Public Comment

Made changes to structure and bylaws and collected public comments

Revised Bylaws

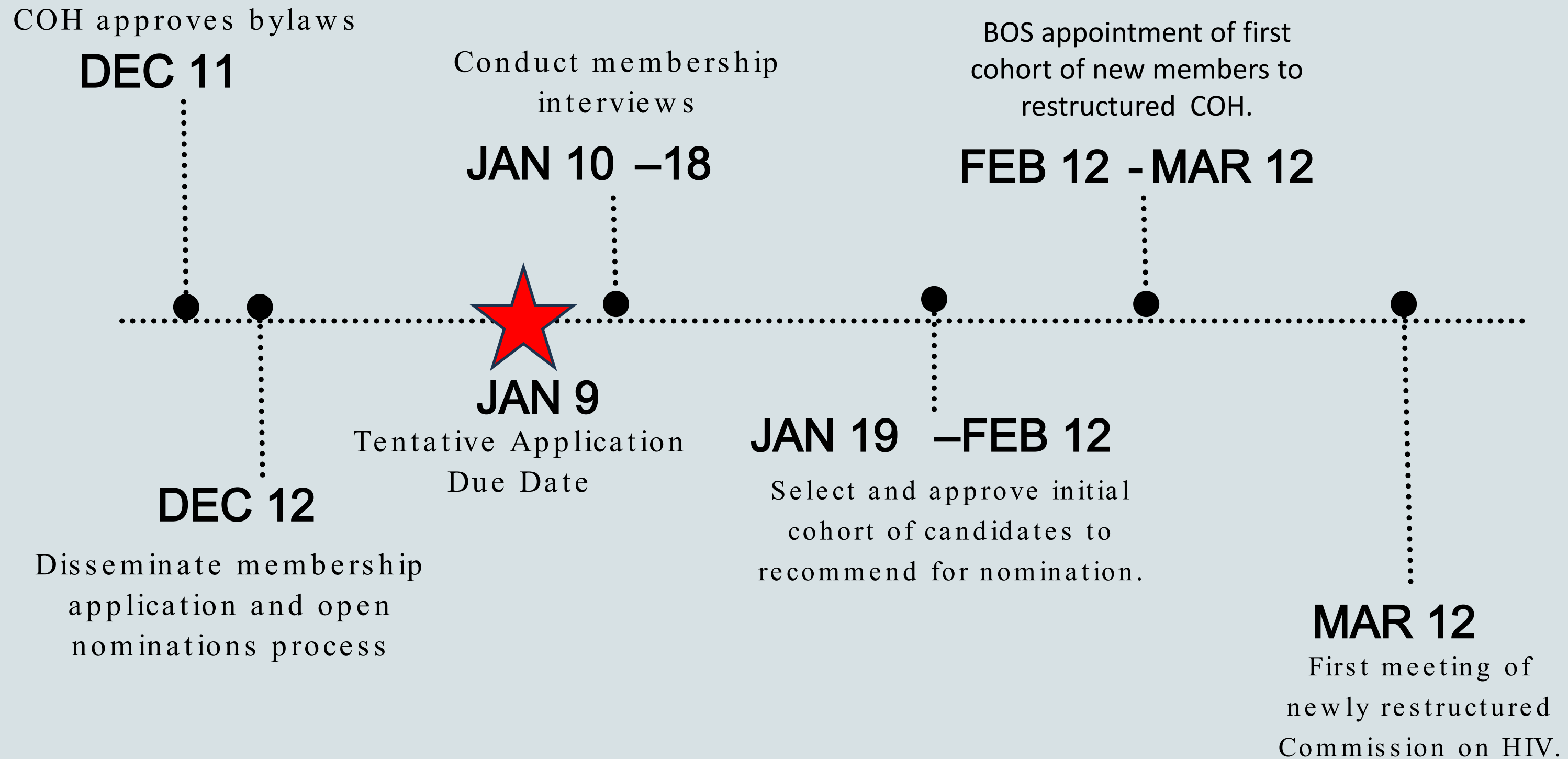
Revised bylaws at Executive Committee level based on feedback



Significant Changes
