## **Requests for Continuance**

- 4. Petition of **LEANOR JOHANSEN** for a hearing on the **discharge**, effective March 31, 2022, from the position of Licensed Clinical Psychologist, Department of Mental Health, based on the claim of a Civil Service Rule 25 violation, **Case No. 22-89**. CONTINUE AT THE REQUEST OF THE PETITIONER, IN ORDER FOR HER TO SEEK LEGAL COUNSEL.
