Ms. Spinner is a lifelong volunteer and has served on numerous organizations, including the UBS Foundation and Endowment Committee and the Fulfillment Fund, an organization that helps make college a reality for students living in under-resourced areas. For 30 years, she has been involved with the organization, serving initially as a mentor to students to now serving as a board member on the Executive Committee. She has assisted many nonprofits in guiding them with effective strategies for planning, development, and board governance.
