

Ms. Amy Bodek, Ms. Angela George Moody, and Mr. Emilio Salas presented on the departments and the Los Angeles County Development Authority's (LACDA) work related to affordable housing.

Commissioner Shevlin inquired about the departments' or LACDA's relationship with the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA). Commissioner Rodarte commented on State mandates related to housing and inquired about public outreach to address NIMBY-ism. Co-Chair Dusseault inquired about and goal-setting and accountability in housing planning.

Dr. Geneviève Clavreul and Ms. Stacy Dalgleish addressed the BRCH.

Commissioner Rodarte commented on policy-making for agile administration of programs. Co-Chair Dusseault inquired about the number of referrals and issues with streamlining the voucher process. Commissioner Greuel inquired about federal policy related to housing vouchers.
