# Trends and Updates

## April to June 2017

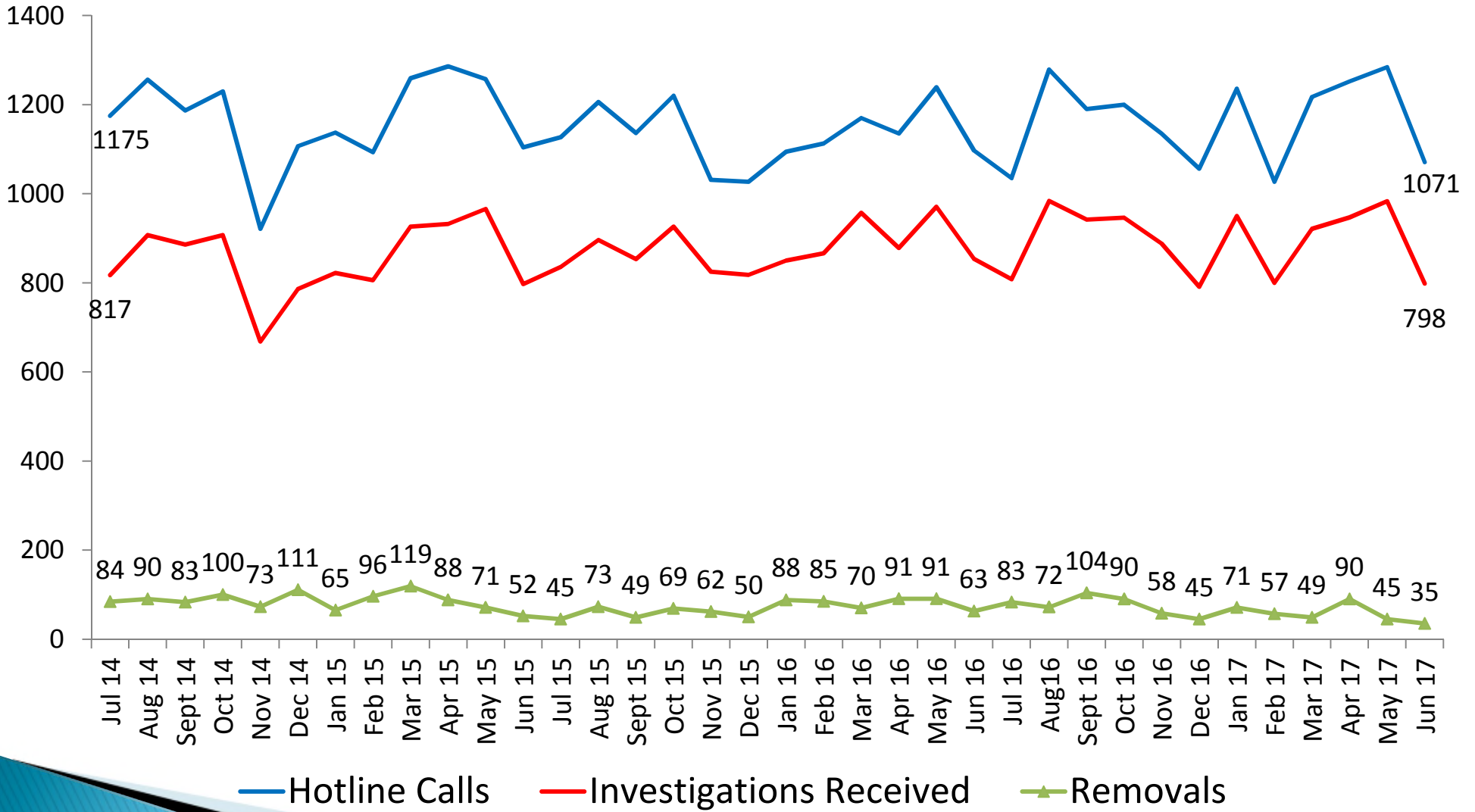
- ▶ Hotline calls and investigations received increased the first two months and then declined significantly in June.
- ▶ Removals trended down all three months with June resulting in the lowest removal rate in the past 3 years.
- ▶ Out-of-home care placements have increased 8.6% since June 2016. During that time, licensed placements decreased 7.4% while relative/non-relative placements increased 25.1%.
- ▶ Since June 2016, foster home placements decreased 13.5% but group home placements increased 19.4% (although group home placements trended down sharply in June).
- ▶ The performance measure targets have been met or exceeded for the following measures:
  - Children under supervision seen every 30 days
  - Rate of abuse or neglect per day while in out-of-home care
  - Children achieving permanency in 12 months for children in out-of-home care 12 to 23 months
  - Adoption finalizations for the 2016–2017 state fiscal year
  - Children in out-of-home care who received medical services within the last 12 months
  - Young adults who aged out of foster care who have completed or are enrolled in secondary education, vocational training, or adult education
- ▶ There has been a net loss of 44 traditional foster home beds since June 30, 2016.
- ▶ As of 6/30/2017, there are 286 traditional foster homes with a total capacity of 586 beds in Circuit One.

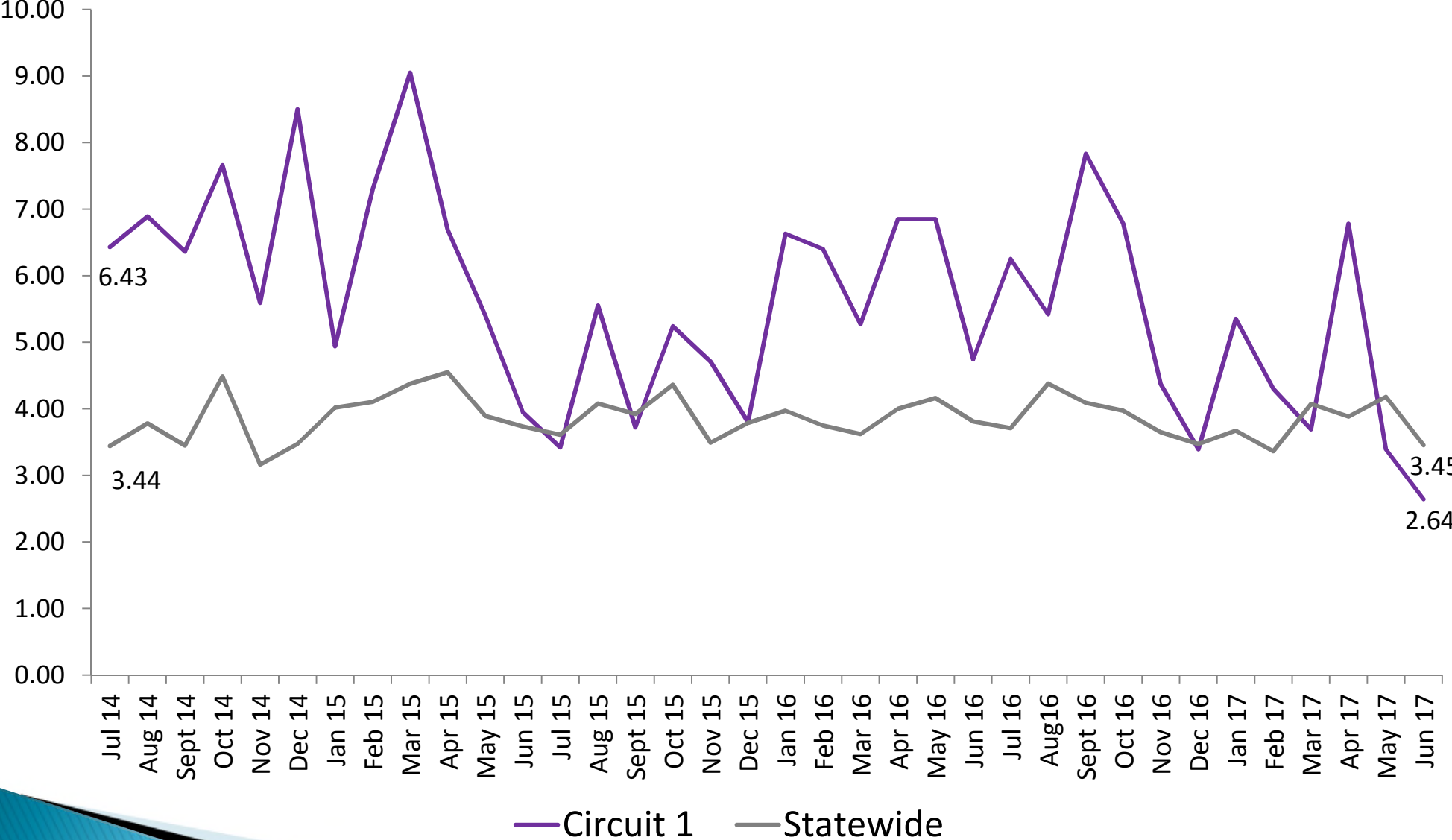

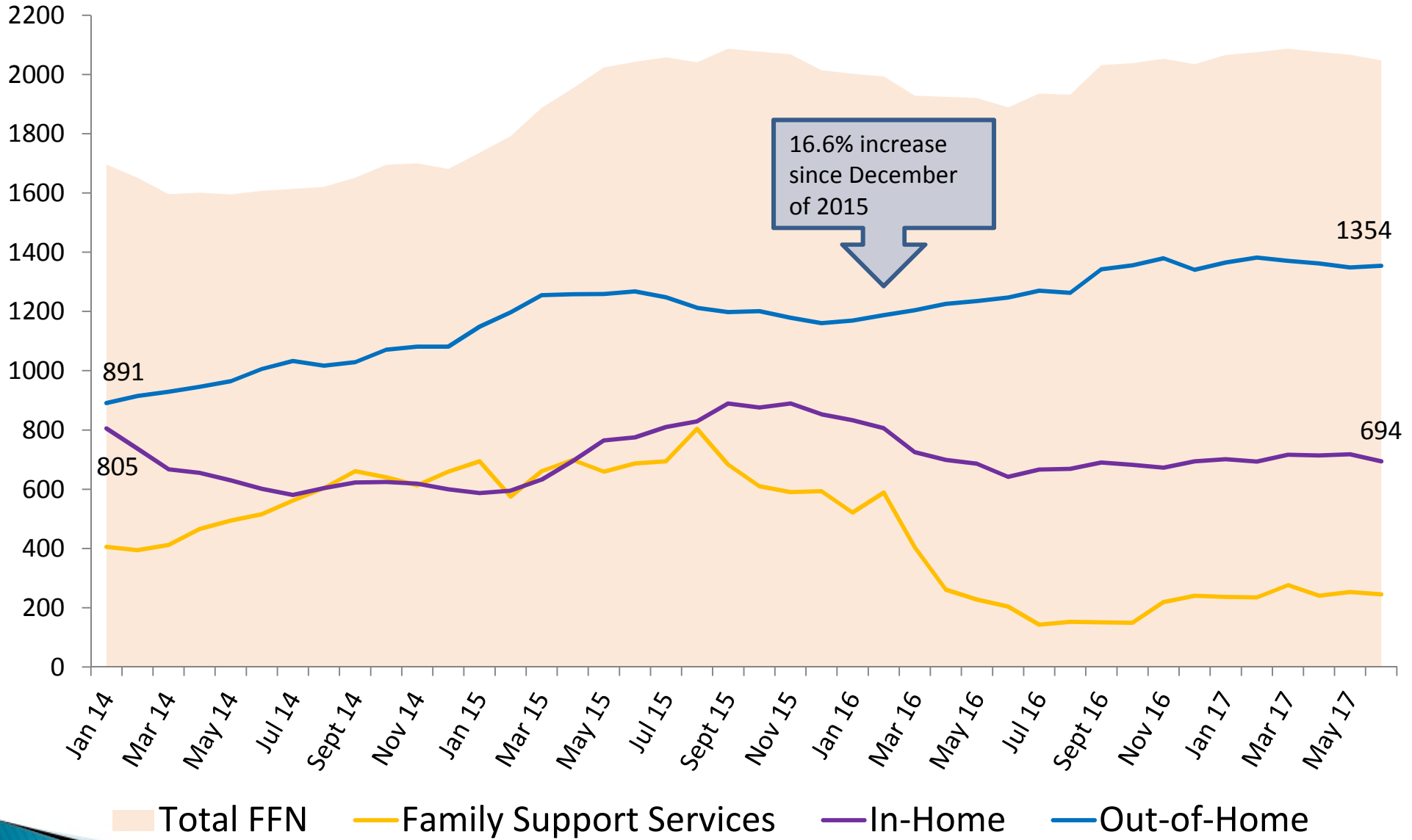
# Removal Rate Per 1,000 Children Circuit One vs. Statewide



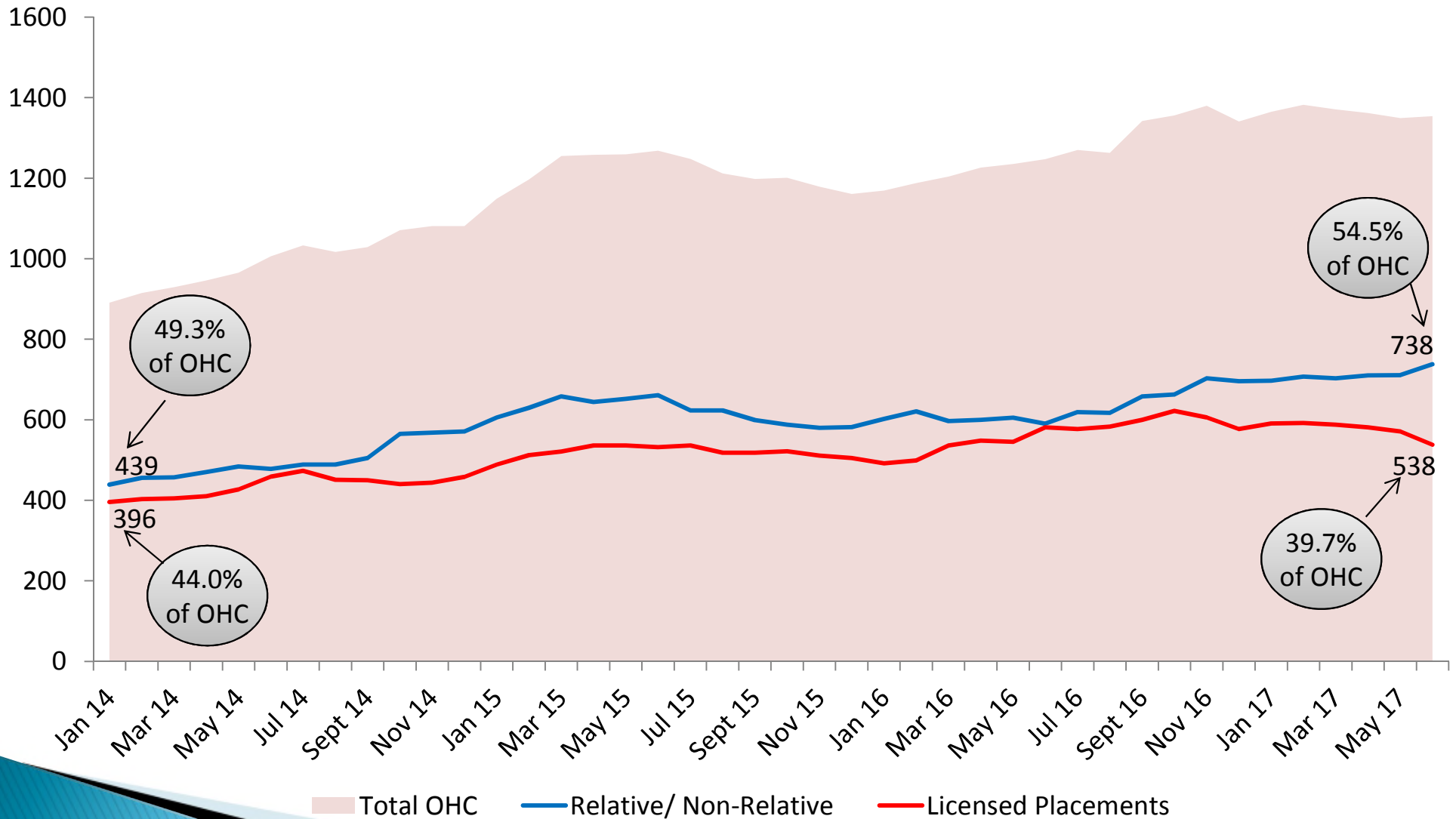

# Comparison of Children in Out-of-Home Care and Type of Placement Circuit One

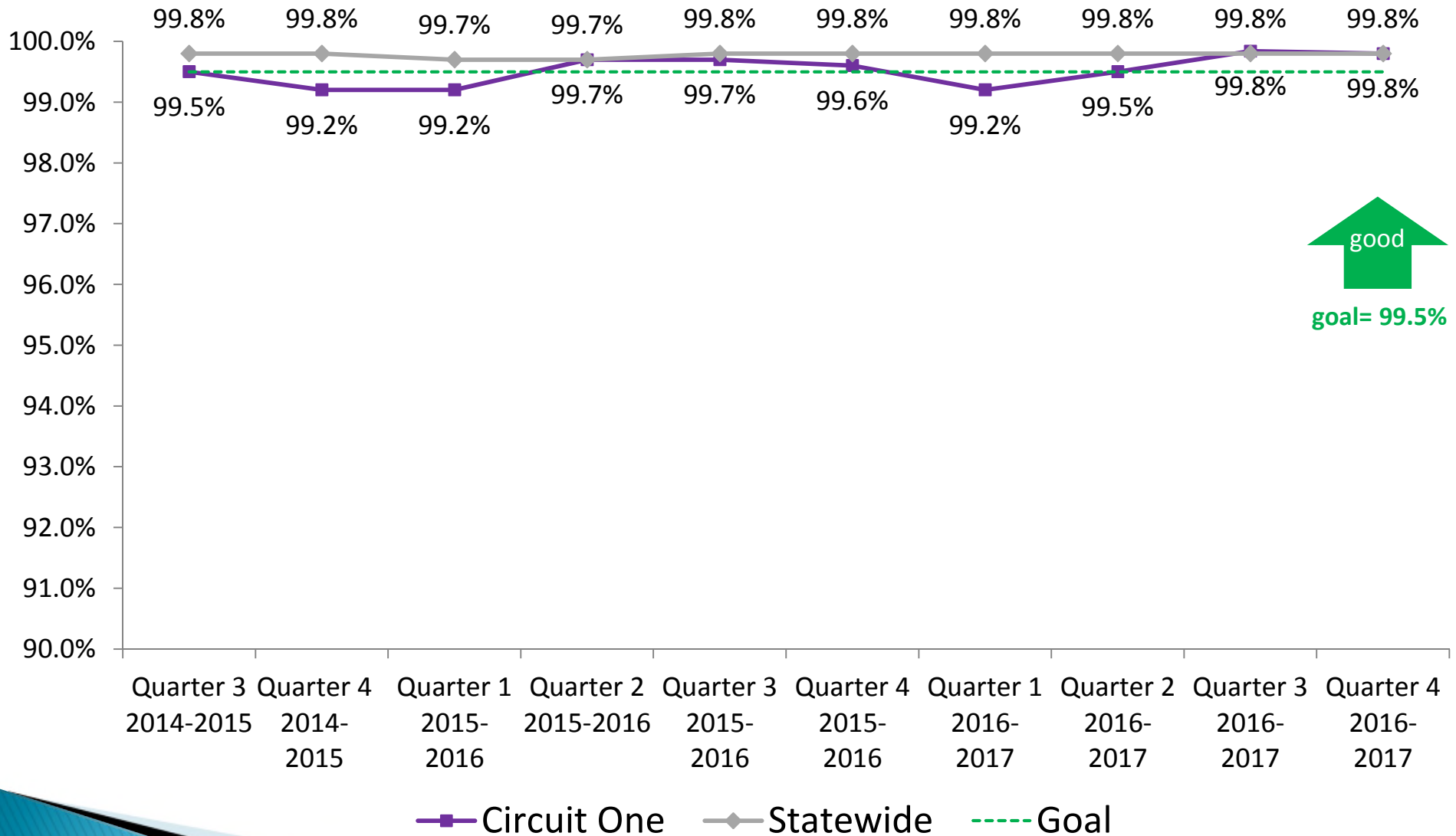




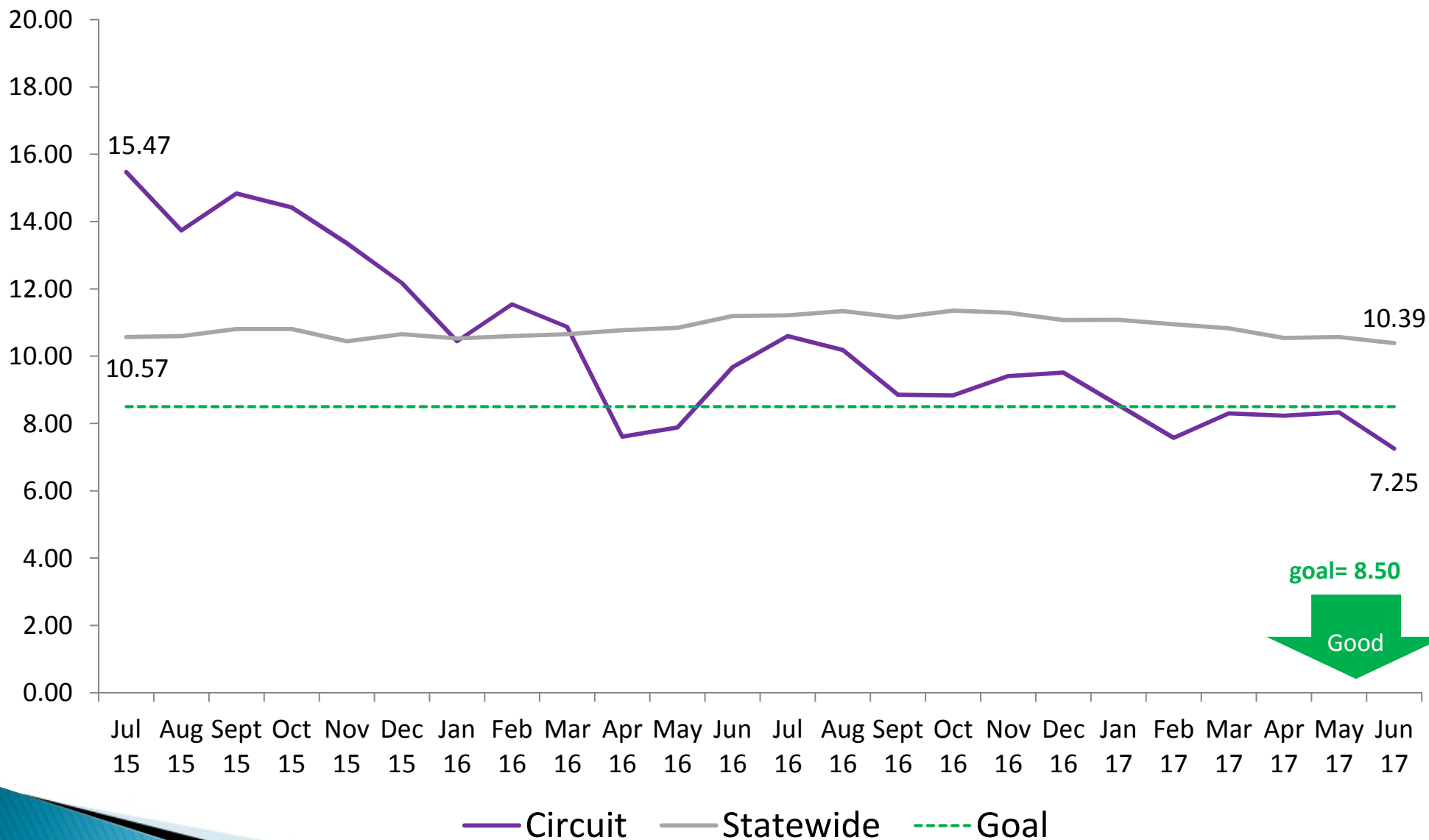

# Percent of Children Under Supervision Seen Every 30 Days Circuit One



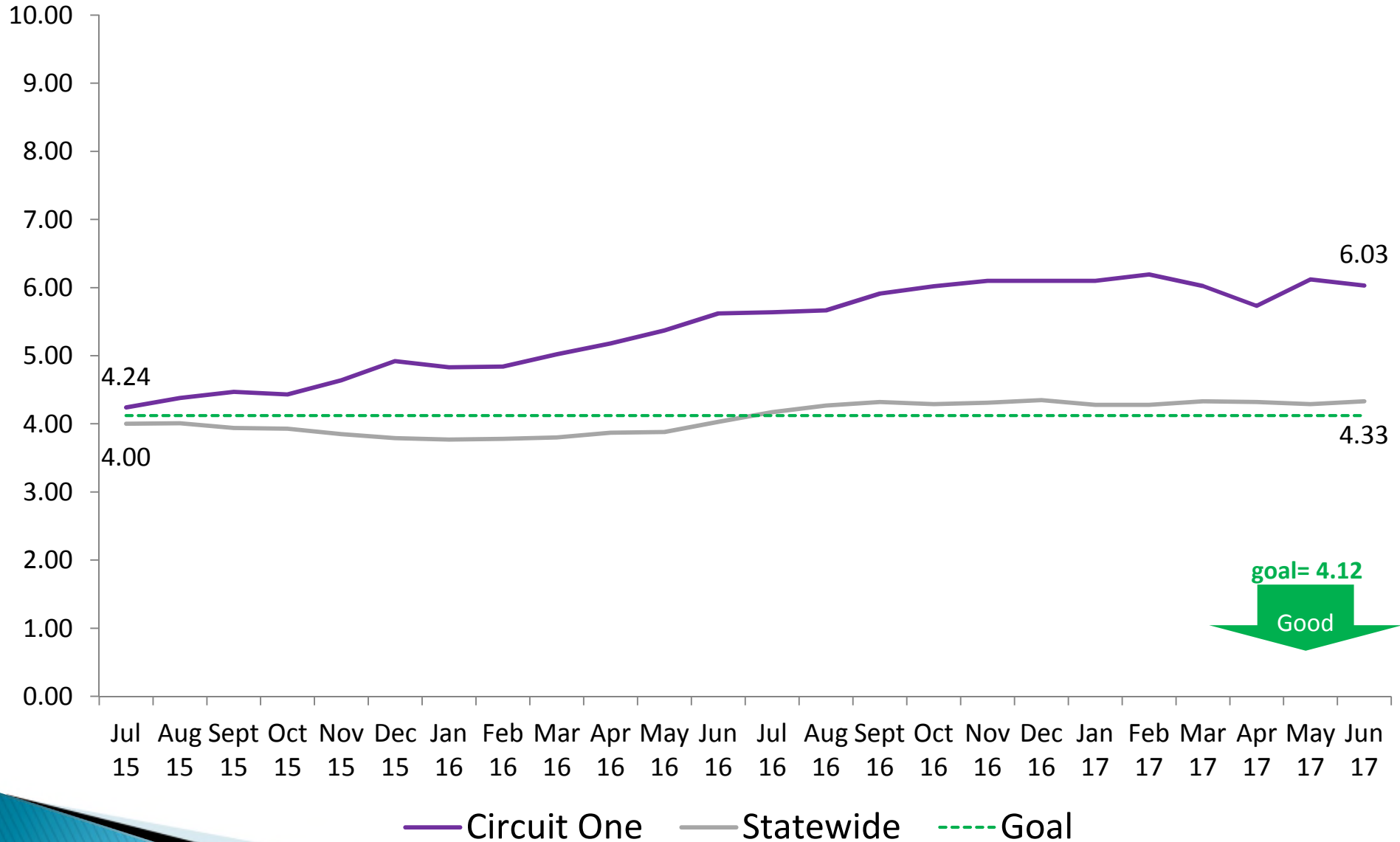
# Rate of Abuse or Neglect per Day While in Out-of-Home Care Circuit One



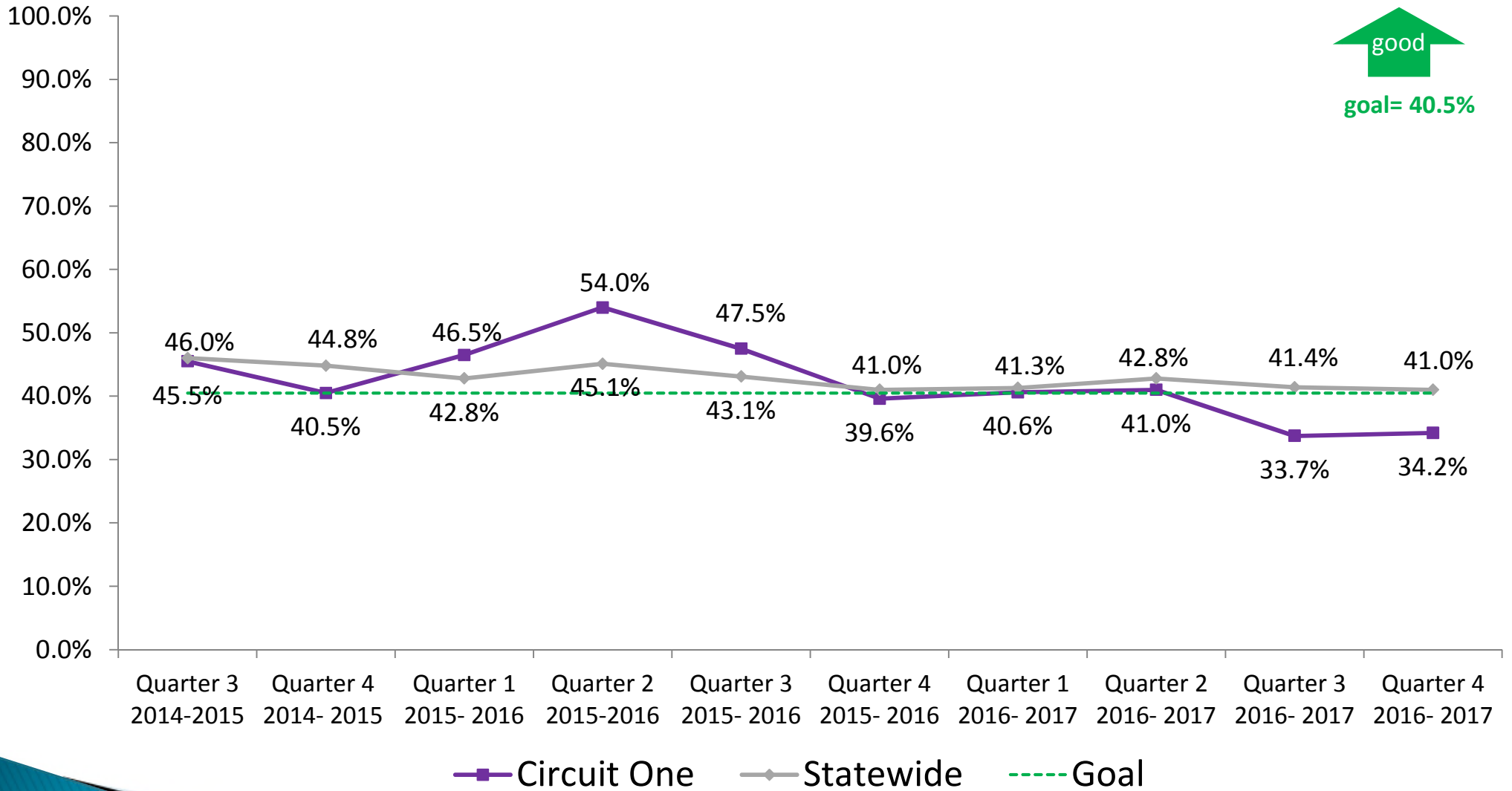

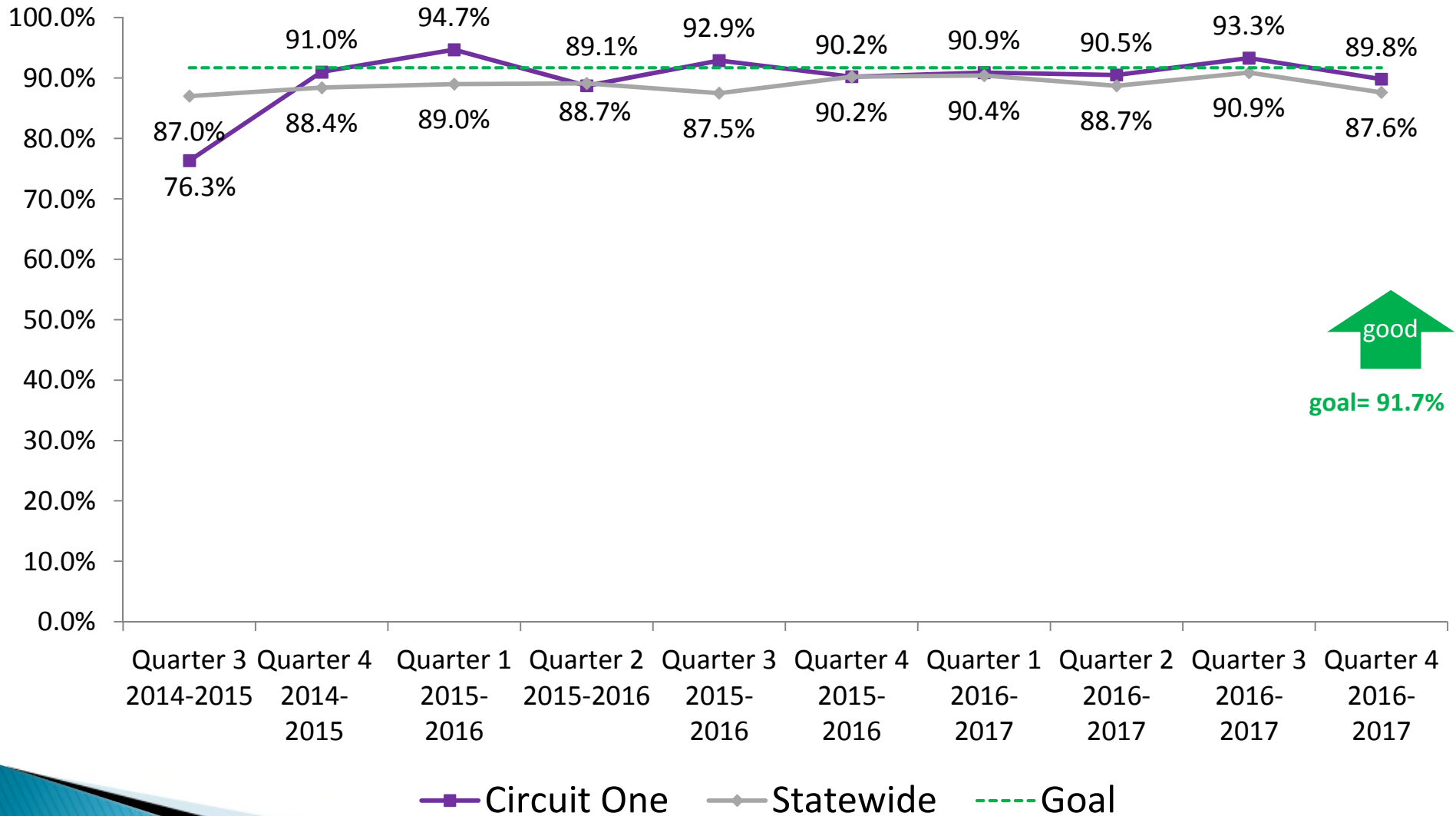
# Rate of Placement Moves Per 1,000 Days in Out-of-Home Care Circuit One



# Children Exiting Out-of-Home Care to a Permanent Home within 12 Months Circuit One

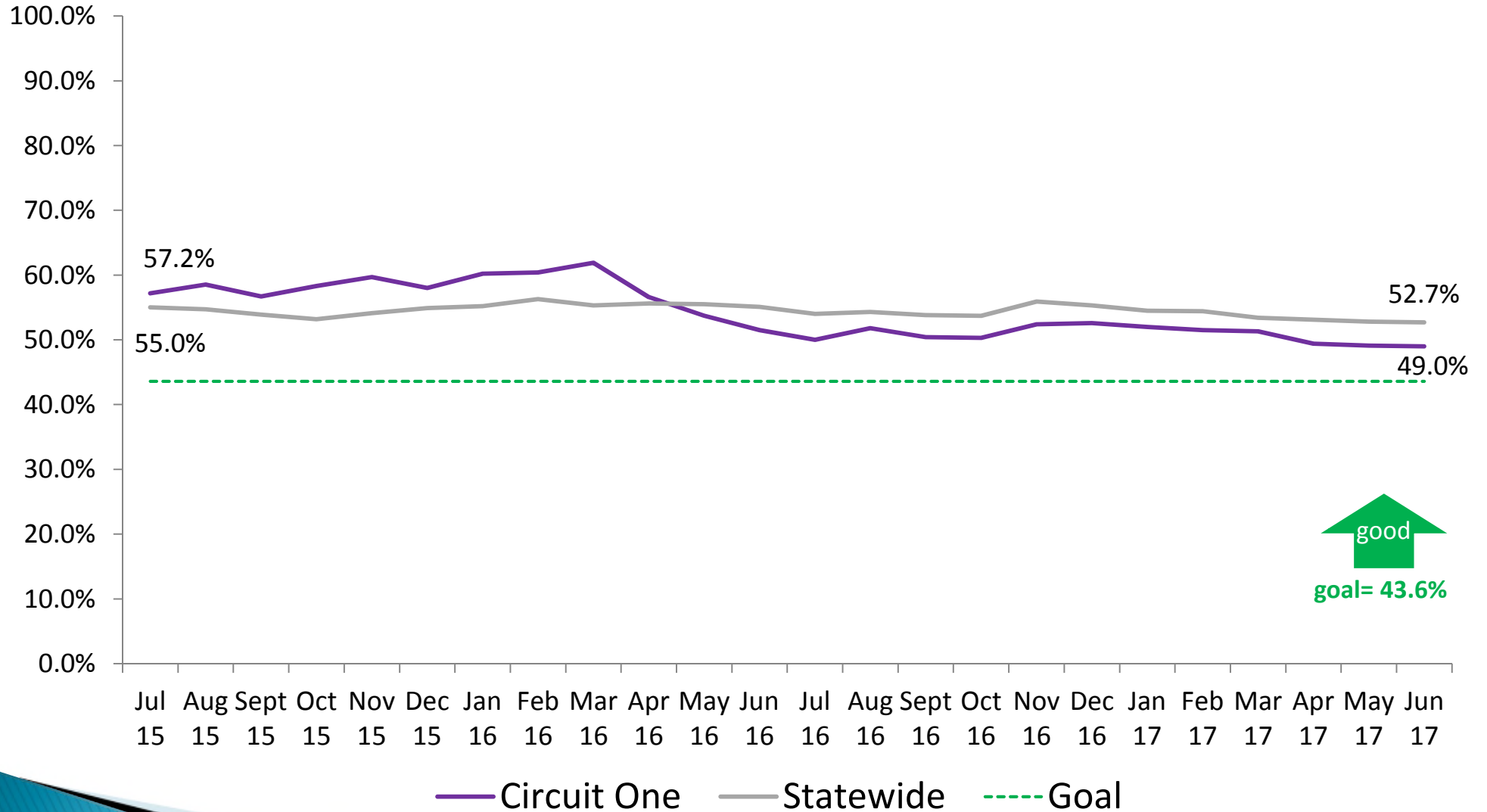


# Children Who Do Not Re-Enter Out-of-Home Care within 12 Months of Moving to a Permanent Home Circuit One

# Children Achieving Permanency in 12 Months for Children in Out-of-Home Care 12 to 23 Months Circuit One

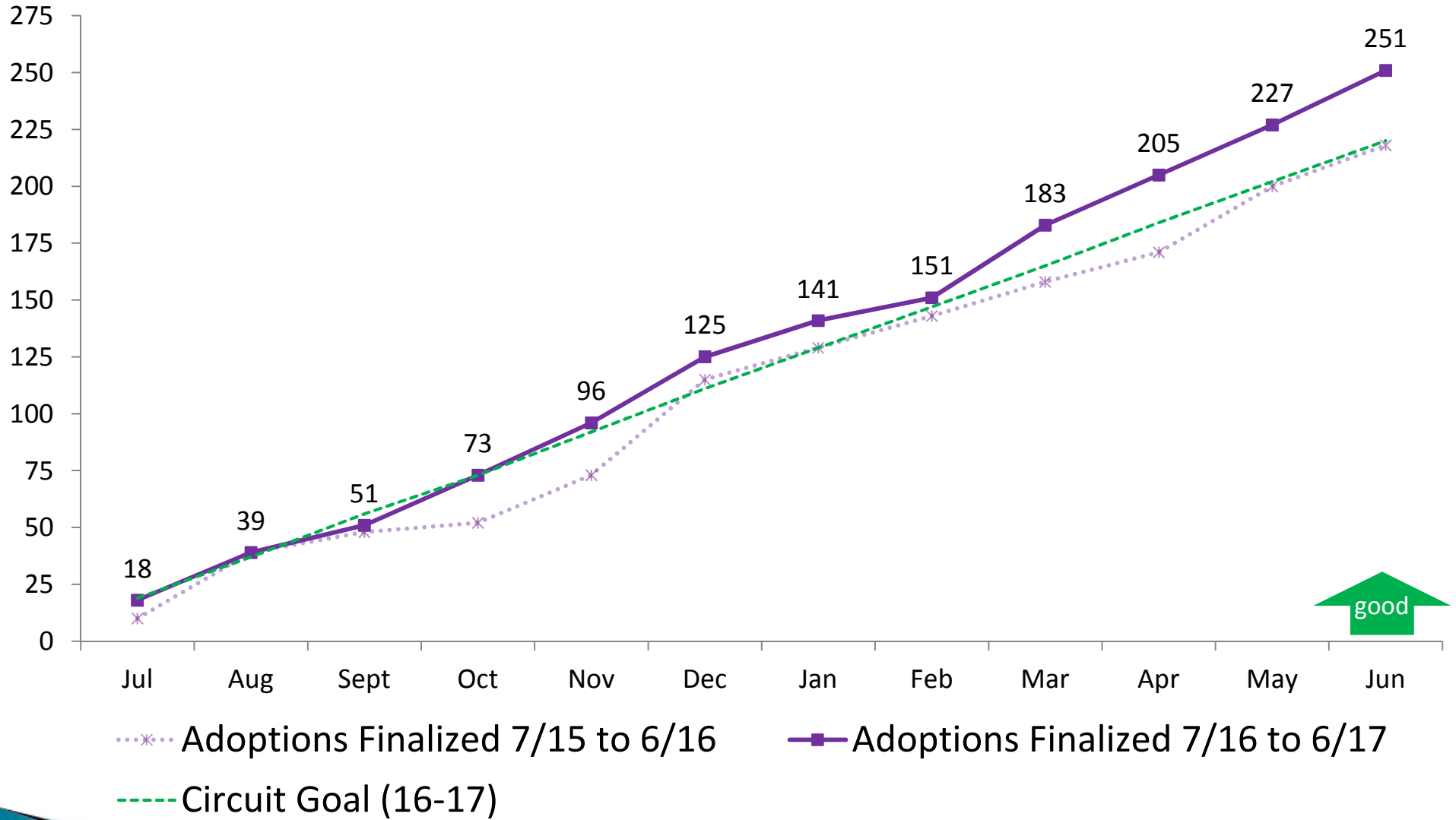

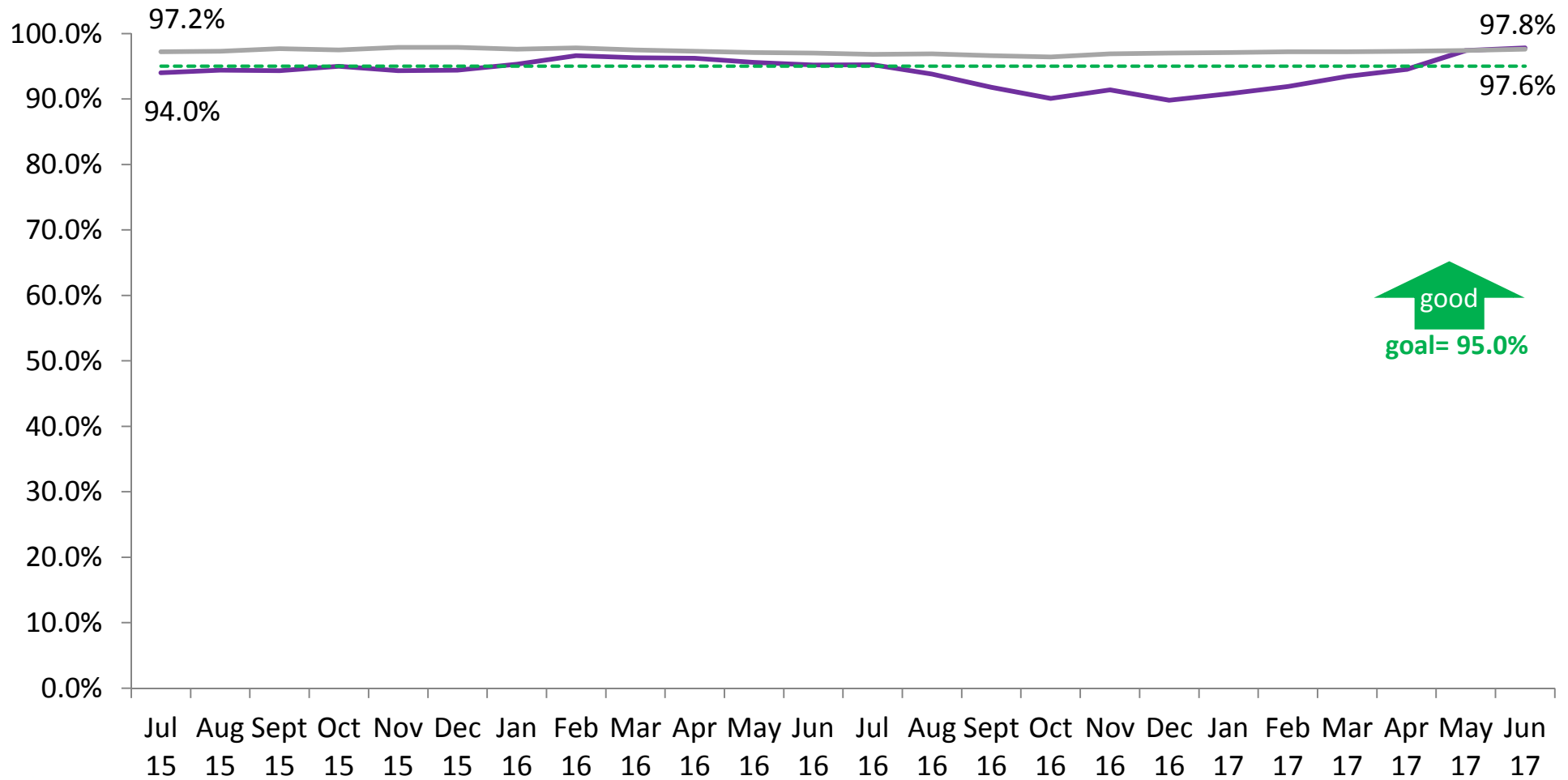

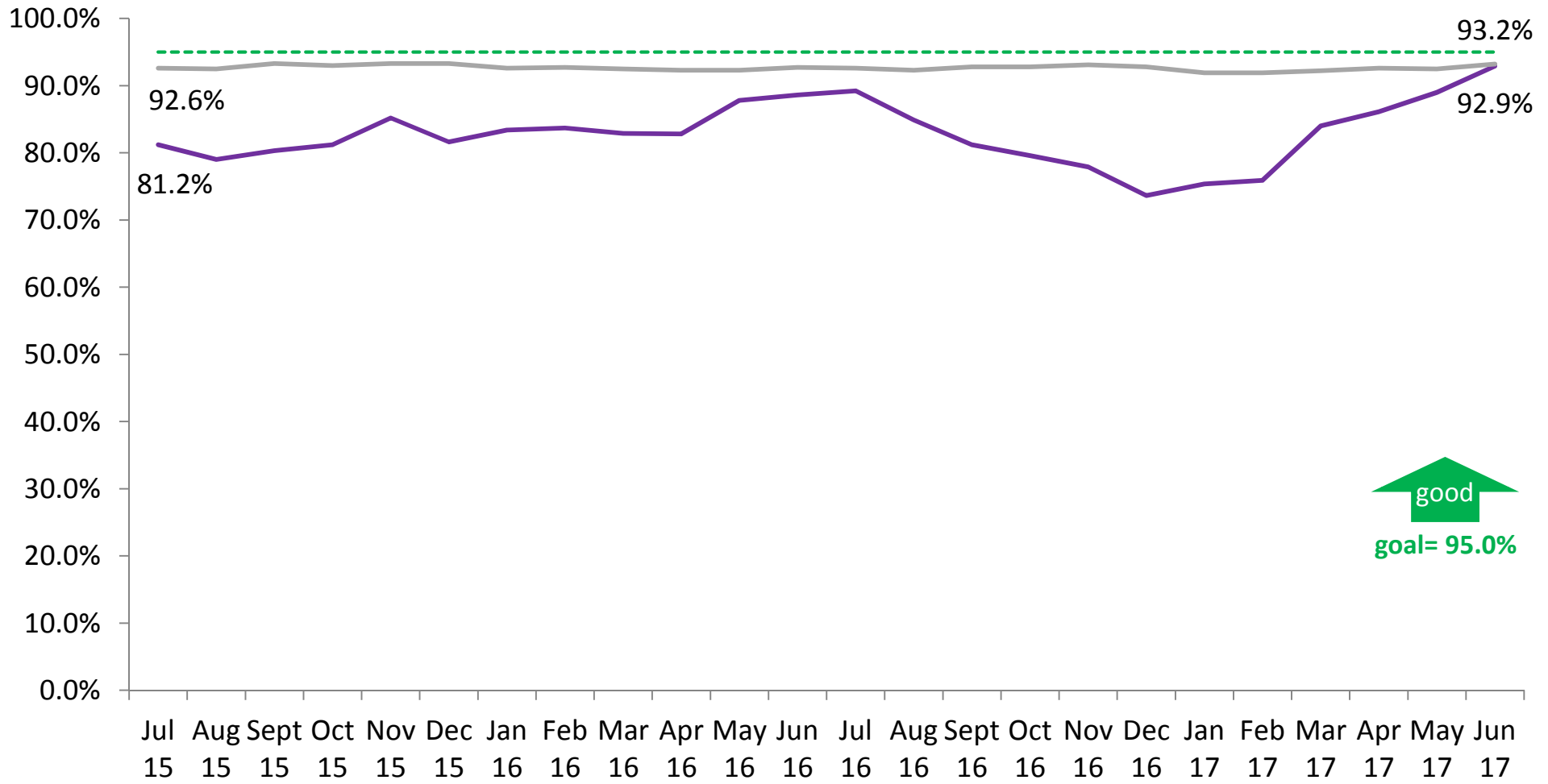
# Children in Out-of-Home Care Who Received Medical Services within the Last 12 Months Circuit One

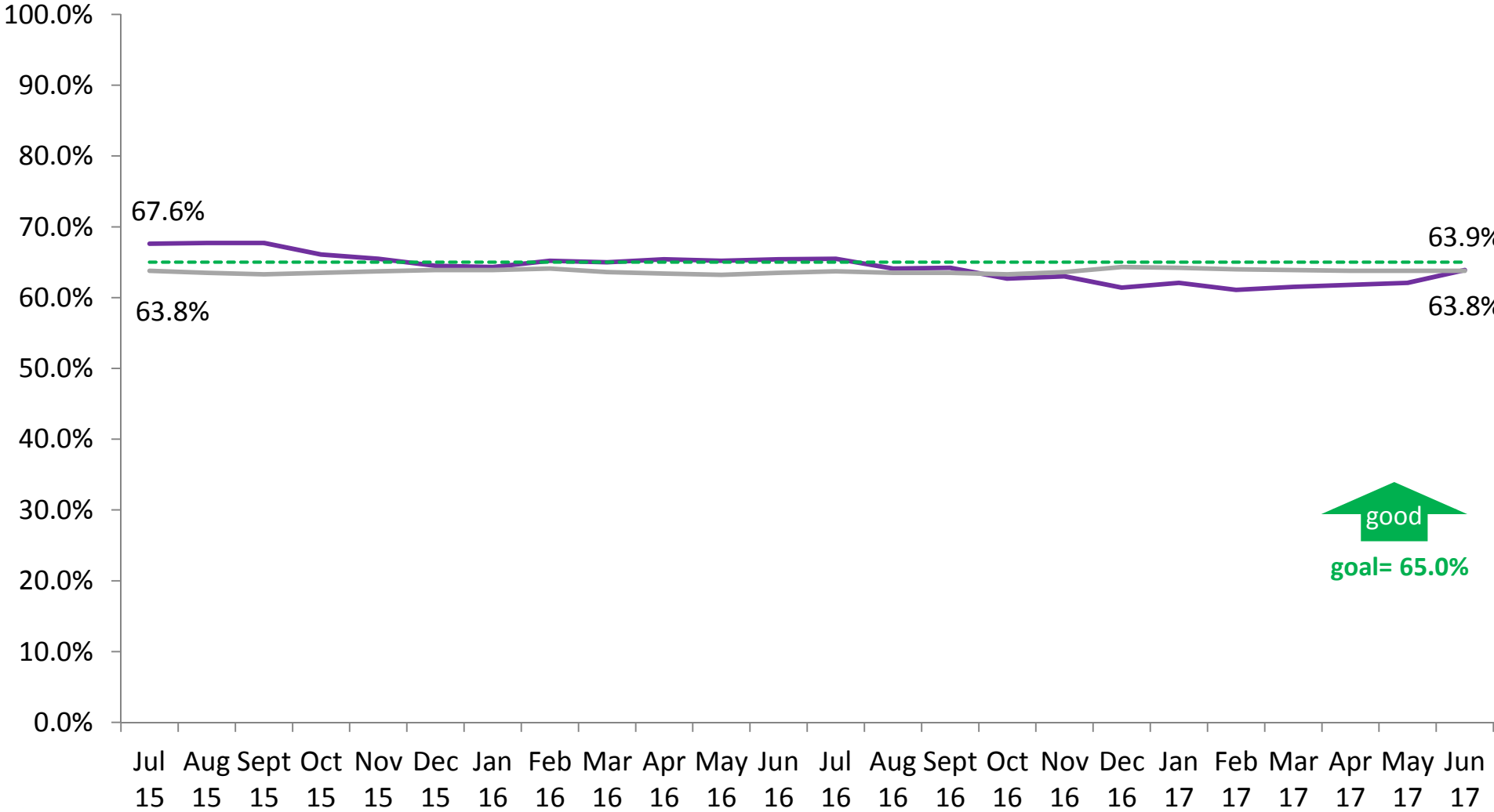
# Children in Out-of-Home Care Who Received Dental Services within the Last 7 Months Circuit One

# Sibling Groups Where All Siblings Are Placed Together Circuit One

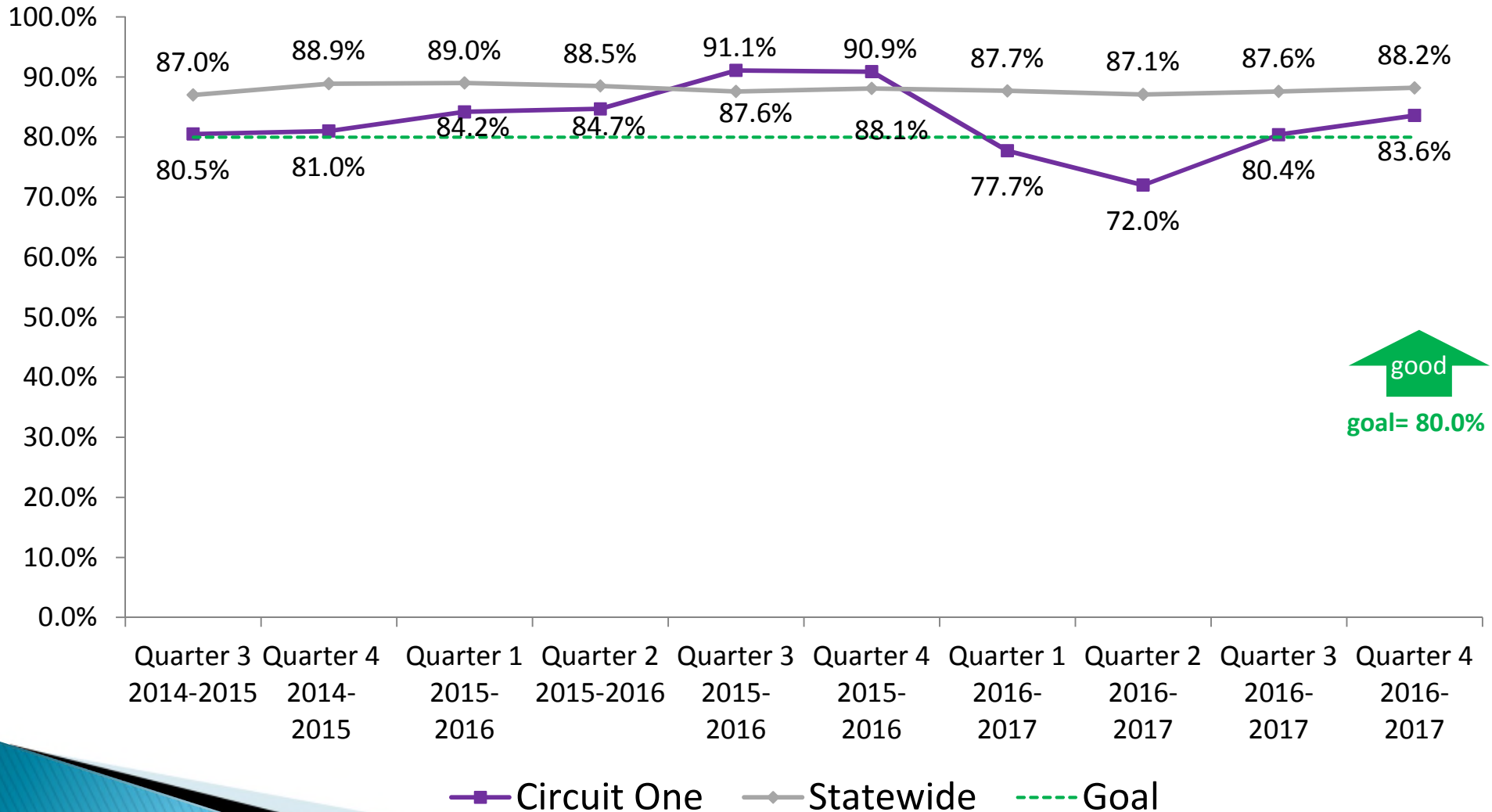

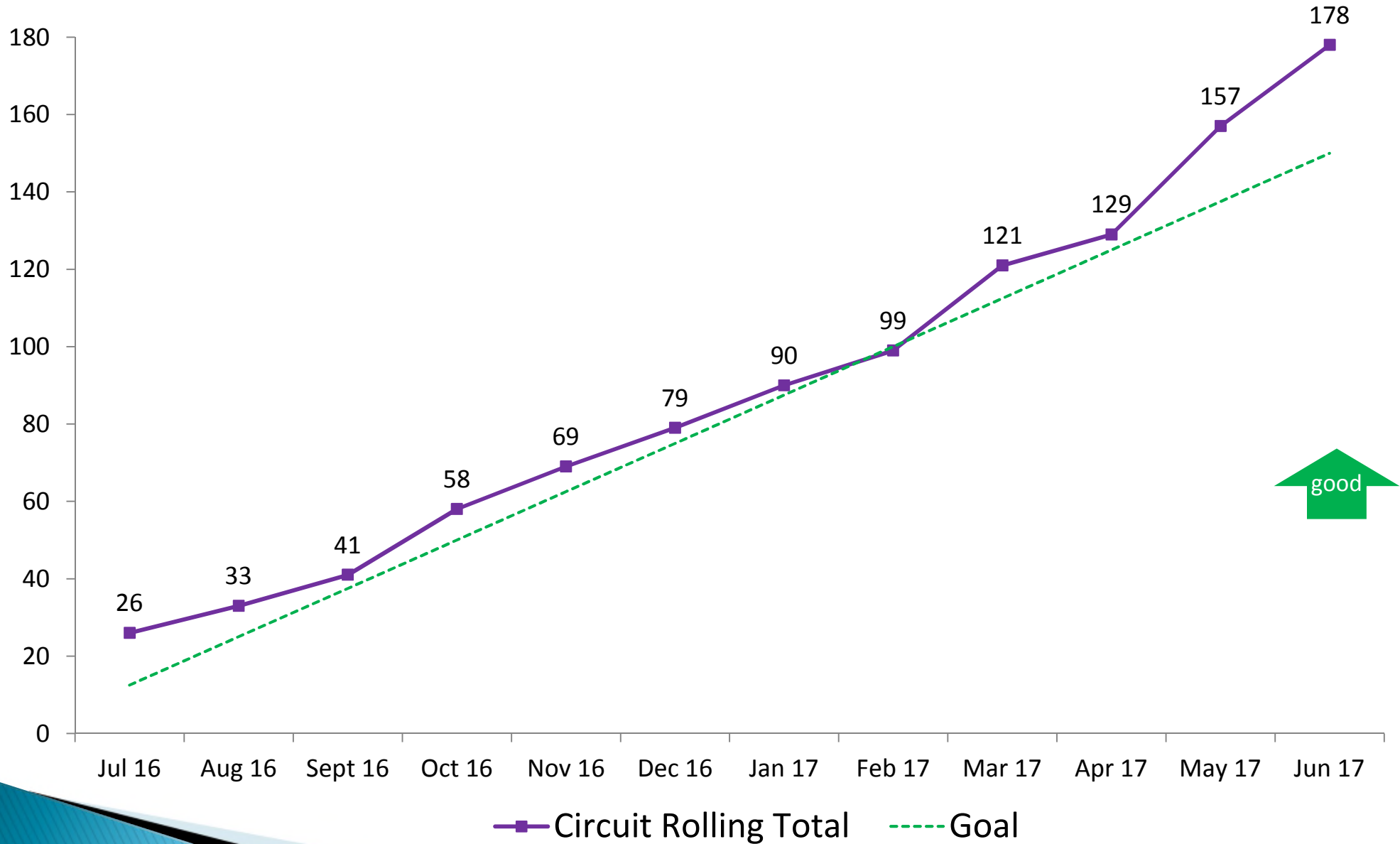
