NEW item code for CT Angiography Pulmonary Arteries - 57357

- New item for CT Angiography Pulmonary Arteries, when used for exclusion of pulmonary embolism does not require the GP to indicate on the request a discussion between them and a Specialist/Consultant took place (point iii. below).
- All other use of this new item (PA stenosis, occlusion or aneurysm) when requested by a GP still require the request to indicate a discussion between the GP and a Specialist/ Consultant took place.
- All other GP requested CT Angio items still require the request to indicate a discussion between the GP and a Specialist/Consultant took place.
- 57357 Cannot be claimed with another CT item.
- The service is:
 - i. Performed for the exclusion of pulmonary arterial stenosis, occlusion, aneurysm or embolism and is requested by a Specialist/Consultant; or
 - ii. Performed for the exclusion of pulmonary arterial stenosis, occlusion or aneurysm and is requested by a medical practitioner (other than a Specialist/Consultant) and the request indicates that the patient's case has been discussed with a specialist or consultant physician; or
 - iii. For the exclusion of pulmonary embolism and is requested by a medical practitioner (other than a Specialist/Consultant physician).

Correction to vascular ultrasound restrictions

- Implemented on the 1st May 2020 was a removal of restrictions with co-claiming general/ obstetric/MSK ultrasounds with vascular ultrasounds. Due to an error on behalf of Dept of Health a restriction was added with low leg MSK ultrasounds that they could not be coclaimed with any vascular item code.
- Correction to this the following vascular items can now be billed with lower leg MSK items code when requested/performed: 55284, 55292, 55282, 55280 and 55248.
- Lower leg vascular items still restrict with lower leg MSK ultrasound item codes (knee down to feet).
